HAPPY BIRTHDAY— to us! Today we celebrate the birthday of the Church, that is, of the Mystical Body of Christ in the world and for the world.



“The Firstborn Brother” – “We become by grace what God is by nature”, taught St. Athanasius (d. 373), a Doctor of the Church. St. Basil the Great (d 379), another Doctor of the Church, wrote, “*Through the Spirit we acquire a likeness to God; indeed, we attain what is beyond our most sublime aspirations--- we become God*”. Christ Jesus is “the firstborn of many brothers” (Romans 8:29) and it is the passionate desire of God that all human beings become, over time and through grace, completely one with Christ, and therefore completely “in God” (Theosis). What is God like? What are some signs of God-like-ness revealed in the revolution who is Jesus, “the image of the invisible God” (Colossians 1:15)? Well...



REVEALING ATTIRE – The outermost vestment that a Pope or an Archbishop wears is called the Pallium which is made from lambswool and is meant to be the “first thing”, the uppermost thing, the outermost thing we notice when we look at the earthly leaders of the Church. The pallium calls to mind a lamb on the shoulders of a shepherd and recall Jesus’s words, “The Son of Man has come to seek and to save what was lost” (Luke 19:10). Actions speak and the action of wearing a pallium “shouts” that we are to be a community whose first priority, uppermost interest and outermost characteristic is seeking out and serving those who are lost: certainly those who are lost in sin, but also those who are lost in addiction; have lost their health; lost their hope; lost their bearings; lost their identity; lost their faith.



The Firstborn of Creation – Jesus is not only “the firstborn of his brothers” (Rm. 8:29) but He is also the “firstborn of all creation for in him all things were created...all things we created through him and for him...in him all things hold together...he is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead...” (Colossians 1:15-18). After the Ascension of Jesus, creation has entered into the Creator! The mission of Jesus is way bigger than just saving us from our sins. The mission of Jesus is about restoring all creation into right relationship with the Father.

PARISH FEAST – The Feast of Saint Ann and Joachim is July 26, and our parish has a tradition of extending the Feast of our parish’s Patron Saint into a three day celebration (a “Triduum”) from July 24 through July 26. More details will be coming soon but we want you to know that we have booked Frank Runyeon <https://www.runyeonproductions.com/> to return to our parish and present the “Sermon on the Mount” followed by “Hollywood vs. Faith” on Sunday July 24 from 6:00 to 7:30 PM. Frank’s presentation will be preceded by a Food Festival on the parish lawn. Again, stay tuned for further details about this year’s St. Ann Triduum.

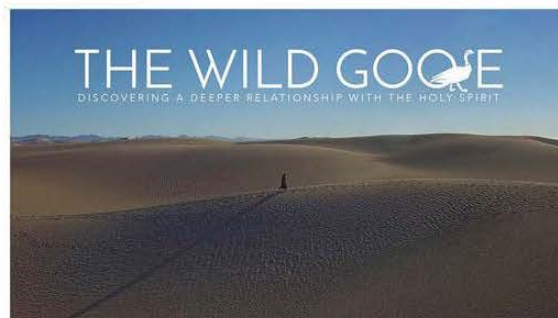

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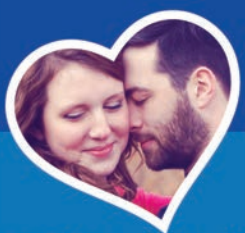
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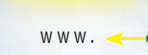
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
