**"Let Us Pray"** - The twin sources of our Faith are: 1) Scripture and 2) Tradition. That said, how do Scripture and Tradition *enter us* and *become part of* our memories, hopes, words, choices and actions?

The chief way is through the *celebration of* the Liturgy. This has been expressed poetically in the Latin phrase "Lex Orandi, Lex Credendi, Lex Vivendi" which can be translated as: "How we Pray = How we Believe = How we Live".



**Seeing the Form** is the title of the first book in the major theological series titled *The Splendor of the Lord* by Hans Urs Von Balthazar. Seeing the form, connecting the dots, discerning the pattern, marinating in the Mystery that lies below the surface of normal sensory

perception is perhaps the chief way in which liturgical celebration shapes us. Ritual makes visible what is most real; liturgical celebrations bring to light the Deep Truth as they re-immense and conform us more deeply to the One Who Is Truth Itself. That said, today is a good day to review and to preview the **liturgical trajectory** ("Lex Orandi") that brings to light and helps us connect the dots regarding how we are to live ("Lex Vivendi").



**MBS** - We can never capture nor begin to exhaust the mystery that is Most Blessed Sacrament (MBS) of the Eucharist. That said, to encounter the Eucharistic Lord and also to hand on the Faith to each generation, our Tradition presents three main avenues of approach to the Eucharist: 1) Sacrifice; 2) Meal; and 3) Presence. Each year on Holy Thursday we accent the MBS as sacrifice (Jesus washes the feet of his disciples) and the MBS as meal ("Take and eat this is my body. Take and

drink this is my blood of the new covenant"). Today, on the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ, our Tradition highlights for us the MBS as the Real Presence of the Lord.



**Solemnity Of the Body And Blood Of Christ** – Every Mass ends with a procession as we carry the One we have received in Holy Communion out of the church and into the world. That said, since we are still rebooting our liturgical ministries and since we are still rebuilding the number of our liturgical ministers, today we would be concluding at least one Mass with a solemn, communal--outdoor procession with the Eucharistic Jesus visibly present in a monstrance. The celebration that we began 103 days ago on Ash Wednesday cannot be completed until what has happened to us **inside** church is moved **outside** the church into the street, the marketplace, the work place, the home. The Doctor of the Church, St. Teresa of Jesus (d.1582) taught that the purpose of grace is "good works, always good works", and after she had died her sisters found these words in her prayer book:

"Christ has no body now but yours;  
no hands but yours; no feet but yours.  
Yours are the eyes through which  
he is to look out Christ's compassion  
to the world. Yours are the feet  
with which He is to go about doing good.  
Yours are the hands with which He is  
to bless others now."



**An Affair of The Heart** – In the end though, after all the good works have been done, religion is an affair of the heart, and this is

why the final two ripples of each Paschal Triduum are the Solemnity of the **Sacred Heart** of Jesus (this Friday) and the Memorial of the **Immaculate Heart** of Mary (this Saturday). Only then, with our hearts touched and rekindled, can we return fully into Ordinary Time. As Pope Francis has said, “We, the women and men of the Church, *are in the middle of a love story*; each of us is a link *in this chain of love*. And if we do not understand this, we have understood nothing of what the Church is.”

In closing, I offer several movie scenes which ring a bell within me as we come to the final ripples of this year’s Easter Splash, Paschal Plunge. If you are not already familiar with any of these films, perhaps you might frame watching those movies as a spiritual exercise, and so provide a context for these scenes which speak to me as we celebrate the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary. The motto of St. John Henry Newman was “Heart Speaks to Heart”. May this week’s 8:00 AM Masses on Friday and Saturday speak to our hearts “and kindle in our hearts the Fire of God’s Love.”

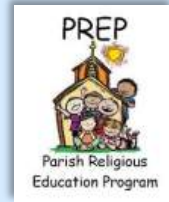

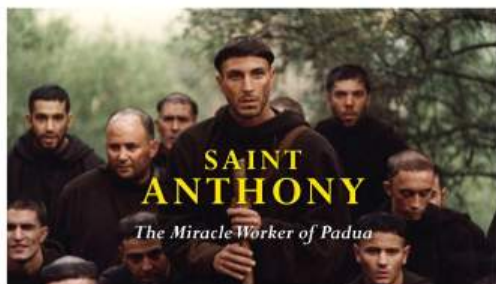
## The Sacred Heart and the Immaculate Heart | Sacred Art
