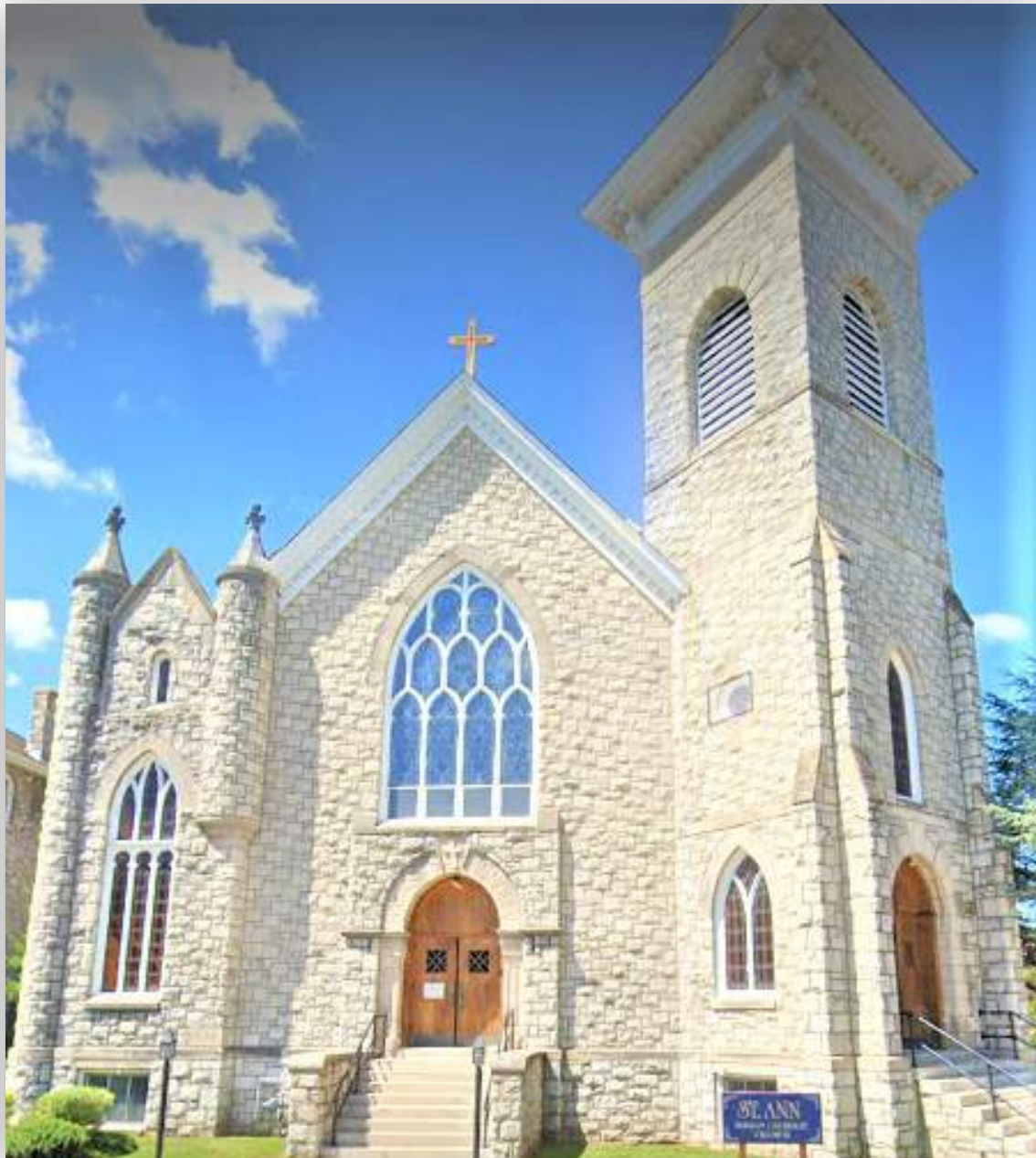

Saint of the Day - Saint Luke the Evangelist



October 18th Saint Luke the Evangelist - (Feast)

Patron Saint of artists, bachelors, bookbinders, brewers, butchers, glassworkers, goldworkers, lace workers, notaries, physicians, and surgeons. Luke is credited with writing the Gospel of Saint Luke and the Acts of the Apostles. Saint Paul identifies Luke in several of his epistles as being his close companion and as a physician. He was also well acquainted with the rest of the apostles. Although he was not an eyewitness of Jesus, he however knew Saint Mark. Luke accurately investigated everything anew and wrote down his findings in an orderly sequence. Luke's Gospel was written after Mark's suggesting it was a source. Dear Friends,



I have written about the upcoming changes to the Mass schedule before, and I have been offering the schedule of priests celebrants in the bulletin so that you have a look at the schedule of both parishes, AND can have a chance to say hello after Mass. Recently, I seem to have spent Saturdays at Saint Mary's and Sundays at Saint Ann, and one of the reasons for that is that the Mass in Spanish is my fixed point. When I have coverage for that, I can more easily switch back and forth. Given that reality, I thought this would be a good time to share a bit more about the principles behind the schedule change. My goal is to have no Masses at the same time so that if the need arose, one priest could do the schedule himself. Also, for routine scheduling it will be easier to identify helping priests.

As I have worked and consulted with Pastoral and Finance Councils I have heard a lot of the priorities. For example: attendance has been a large priority. For some time now and certainly since covid, the 4 PM Saturday at Saint Mary's and the 9:30 AM at Saint Ann are the highest attended Masses for each parish. With those as a fixed point, we have worked to build a schedule around that with alternated Masses. The plan I have moving forward is: another meeting with the Pastoral and Finance Council at Saint Mary's (realized on October 9th), a meeting with the newly formed Pastoral Council at Saint Ann on October 23rd. Then we will have another meeting for parishioners of Saint Ann and Saint Mary to discuss the particulars of the new schedule and ask questions (details soon to follow). The in person meeting will be followed by a webinar meeting that will be recorded so that those who cannot attend will have the opportunity to receive the same information.

The part I will need your help with most, is to get the word out to friends and family. Once the new schedule is published, I will be asking that you commit to a new Mass time and invite friends and family to do the same.
