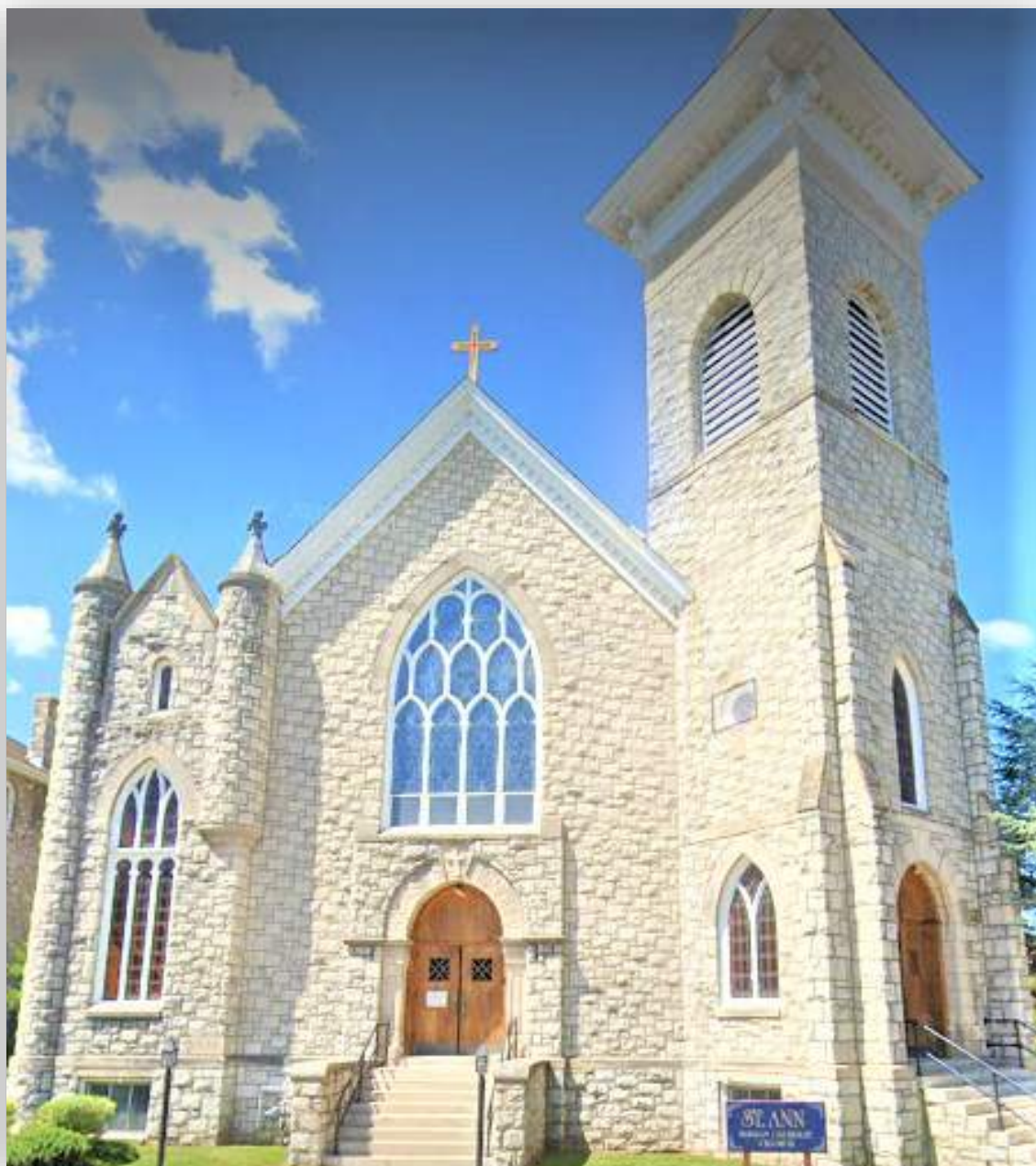

For seventy-two hours – from sunset Holy Thursday evening through sunset on Easter Sunday – we are invited to plunge anew and more deeply than any other time of the year into the Mystery of Jesus' act of passing over from death to life. Though He brought this act to completion in His earthly body over 2000 years ago, He continues to bring it to completion in us, His Mystical Body the Church throughout time and space. This three-day Season is the summit and source of our entire year of common prayer.

Lent has an end. The end...the goal...the purpose of Lent is our devout and fruitful participation in the Paschal Triduum each year and our immersion in the Paschal Mystery every day — a process that spans our entire lifetime.

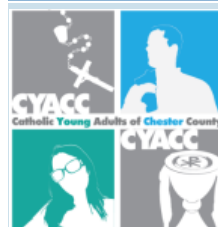

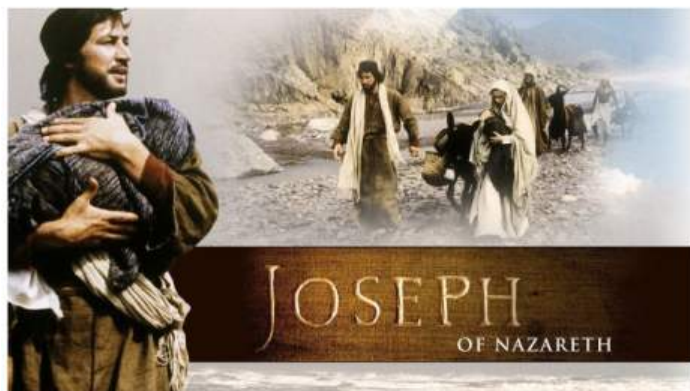
