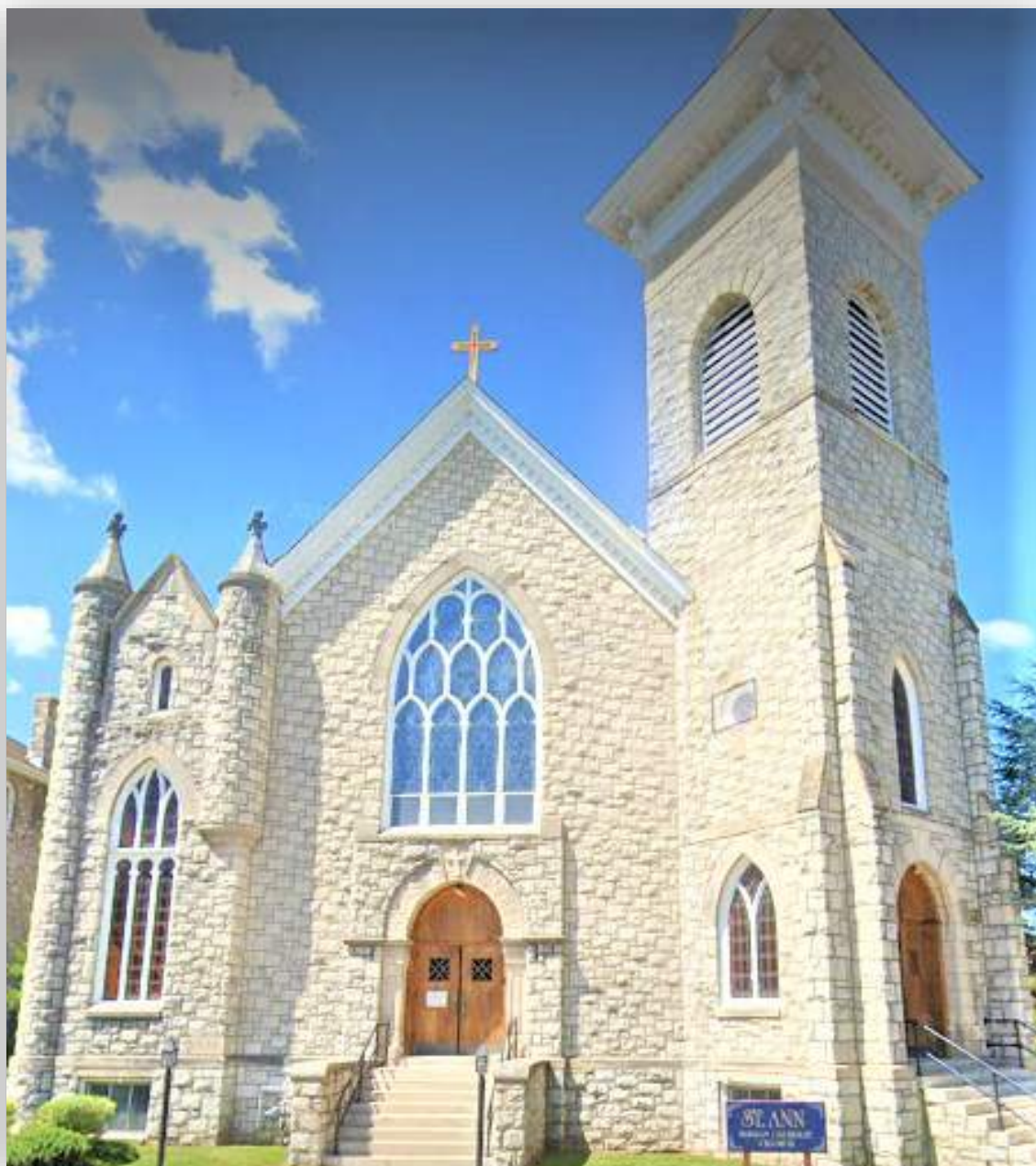

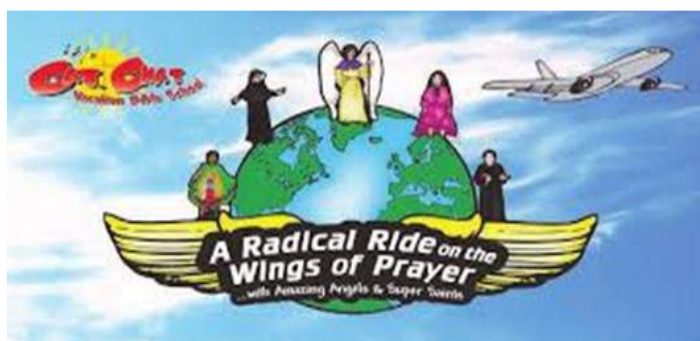

We ask for only the items listed below to fill our pantry bags:

- ♥ Laundry detergent (need 20)
- ♥ Paper towels (need 5 packs)
- ♥ Toilet paper (need 7 packs)
- ♥ Black beans, bagged, 2-lb. (24)
- ♥ Pancake mix (need 28)
- ♥ Pancake syrup (need 15)
- ♥ Cereal/ Oatmeal (need 12)
- ♥ Diapers, sizes 2 and 6
- ♥ Feminine products/toiletries (especially: shampoo, conditioner, deodorant, body wash)
- ♥ Snack items (drink boxes, granola bars, etc. - snack-size only) (need 40)



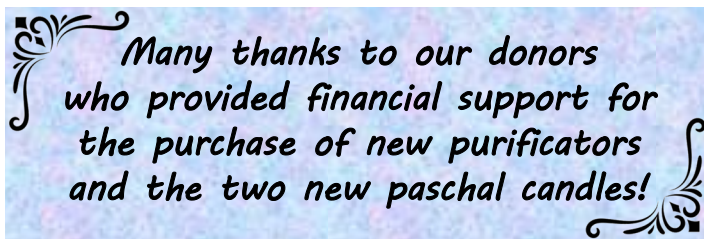
Please note that we can not take perishable items or very large restaurant-sized items.
