Saint of the Week



September 3rd Saint Gregory the Great- (*Obligatory Memorial*)

Pope Gregory contributed to the standardization of the Liturgy by offering clear guidelines and rubrics. He established prayers, the flow of the Mass, and the liturgical year, and helped develop liturgical chant, which came to be known as "Gregorian Chant". Patron Saint of choir boys, educators, masons, musicians, popes, students and singers. He is invoked against gout and plague.

Pre - Congregation Canonization. Declared a Doctor of the Church by Pope Boniface VIII in 1295.

Dear Friends,

It is hard to believe it is September already. I know that Phoenixville School District started earlier this year in favor of more time next summer, and our own Holy Family School is starting this week. The teachers have been back preparing the rooms and preparing themselves for the start of a new school year. The start of a new school year is another opportunity for new beginnings.



New friendships, new students, new things to explore and enjoy. This time of year also introduces new schedules. I have been writing about a new Mass schedule for Saint Ann and Saint Mary of the Assumption Parishes that will take effect in January. Parishioners at both parishes have had the opportunity to give candid feedback following Masses, and I very much appreciate that. There will be an opportunity to share formally as the school year progresses.

The need for a new Mass schedule requires some explaining, so I would like to offer some background information here. Given the declining number of priests, therefore the declining availability of priests, it is helpful to consider what the church can reasonably offer on a local level. The Archdiocese of Philadelphia is currently undergoing a pastoral planning process that is projected for implementation as early as June of 2026. In the meantime they have made use of priests who are already pastors of another parish to assist with parishes that do not have a resident pastor. The details of each circumstance are different. One aspect unique to Phoenixville is that these two parishes were not recently united by a priest prior to the assignments being made in June of this year. The clergy office has officially assigned three priests to Saint Ann Parish: Father Kletzel and I are full time, and Father Donnelley OSA, has been a weekend assistant at Saint Ann's for some time now. Implied in the assignment of Father Kletzel as a parochial vicar of Saint Ann is that he would be assisting with the additional responsibilities at Saint Mary of the Assumption Parish.

In subsequent bulletins I will give more background concerning priest celebrants. I am grateful for your candid feedback up to this point and I look forward to hearing more from you in the coming weeks. For the next couple months you will find the schedule of priest celebrants here each week so that you have a sense of the pattern and needs in this regard.
