Frequently Asked Questions:

- Q. Do we need to pre-order?
- A. YES You must pre-order by 8:30 AM. Teachers are not taking orders in the morning, and the cafeteria needs an accurate count to ensure there is no waste. The food is prepared fresh DAILY.
- O. When will I receive credit for old blue lunch tickets?
- A. The blue lunch tickets have to be verified and will then be credited to the student account. We received a very large amount of these tickets this week and are working to have student accounts credited as soon as possible! Thank you for your patience.
- Q. How do I get my student ID#?
- A. It was sent out over the summer to your SBS parent email address. Each child has an ID# and a 3 digit PIN#. You may call the office or email **grano@stbenedictnj.org** to get this information.
- Q. What happens if I pre-order and change my mind?
- A. Please be aware that you MUST CANCEL your pre-order if you no longer wish to eat hot lunch on a certain day. Please email grano@stbenedictnj.org by 8:30 am in order to cancel your pre-order. Food is prepared fresh daily and this will help minimize waste.


