

- ★ October 31st is a half day with a 12:15 pm Dismissal.
- ★ Only Class Parents will be permitted in the building.
- ★ The Mission Fair will be held outside. Students are asked to make a \$5 monetary donation to the The Pontifical Missions Society in order to play the games. Please have your child(ren) bring a Ziploc bag to hold "prizes."
- ★ The day will begin with our Halloween shows by our PreK3 class in their classroom and PreK4 class in the Great Outdoor Learning Center at 8:30 am. Older siblings will be allowed to attend the show.
- ★ Class parties will begin promptly at 10:30 am. Class parents will receive further instruction from their homeroom teachers. All parties must be wrapped up by 11:25 am.


## LAUREN'S LIGHT: EXPLORERS CLUB
