📏 Entering 2nd Grade

- Fluent in addition and subtraction facts within 20.
- Add and subtract two- and three-digit numbers (up to 1,000).
- Understand hundreds, tens, and ones in big numbers.
- Measure lengths in inches and centimeters.
- **Solve word problems** involving time, money, and measurement.
- Make and read graphs (bar graphs, picture graphs).
- Recognize and draw shapes with specific features.
- **Divide shapes** into equal parts (halves, thirds, fourths).
