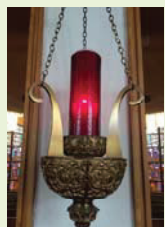

**SEVENTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME
A SHARE IN GOD'S KINGDOM**

Today concludes a three-week series of Gospel texts in which we have listened to a total of seven parables about the Kingdom. The believer is asked to consider the request that God made of Solomon in today's first reading: "Ask something of me and I will give it to you" (1 Kings 3:5). Today's parables about the treasure buried in the field and the pearl of great price should prompt us to answer, "A share in your kingdom, O God!" Today we discover that the kingdom of God is beyond value, a priceless treasure. LOOKING THROUGH STAINED GLASS

Easter Duty

Last week, we discussed the Precept that we should celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation at least once per year. At the end of that column, we suggested that that Precept is related to the next one, the one that we will explore this week, the Easter Duty.

First, let's see what the "Easter Duty" Precept says: You shall humbly receive your Creator in Holy Communion at least during the Easter season. [CCC 2042] Why should we receive the Eucharist during the Easter season? The *Catechism* states that we should do so because it "guarantees as a minimum the reception of the Lord's Body and Blood in connection with the Paschal feasts, the origin and center of the Christian liturgy." [Ibid.]

If you remember our discussion of the Sunday obligation, you may remember that our attendance at Mass each Sunday and Holy Day is for a similar reason, it "requires the faithful to participate in the Eucharistic celebration when the Christian community gathers together on the day commemorating the Resurrection of the Lord." [Ibid.] As mentioned in that column, each Sunday is like a "little Easter." In the present Precept, we are speaking about the actual Solemnity of Easter and the Easter season.

[God is so good to His people that He allowed us to satisfy this Precept even during the pandemic this year. Public Masses were made available in the last week of the Easter season.]

Let's return now to examining why the "Easter Duty" Precept and the Precept regarding Reconciliation are related. In fact, let's examine

why all three of the Precepts we're studying so far are related.

There was a time in the Church's history where people had a real sense of their sin and that caused them to believe that they were unworthy to receive the Eucharist. While it's true that we are all sinners and are all "unworthy" to receive the Eucharist, it is a gift from Jesus, one that He wants us to receive. So, the Church gave us the current Precept of the "Easter duty," so that we would at least receive the Eucharist once a year; and she gave us the Precept regarding Reconciliation, so that we would receive the Eucharist worthily. In many people's minds then, these two Precepts were linked and were often thought of together as the Easter Duty.

Finally, the Church gave the Precept of the Sunday obligation, so that all people would at least receive the gift of God's word and the prayers of the Church every week, even if they felt that they were unworthy to receive the Eucharist regularly.

[In today's world, where our sense of sin is so greatly diminished, the Precept regarding Reconciliation applies so that we might recognize our need for a Savior, a merciful and forgiving God.] This reality leads us into our need for following the next Precept regarding observing the penitential times of fasting and abstinence.

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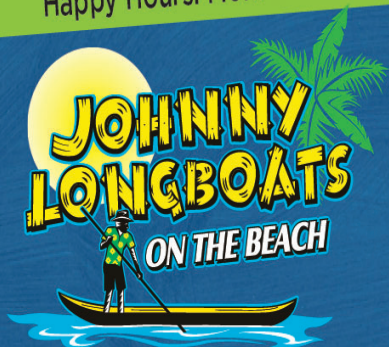
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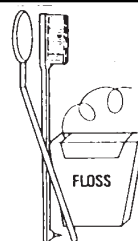
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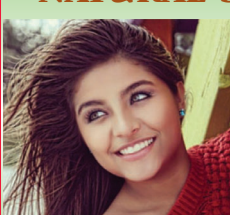
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
