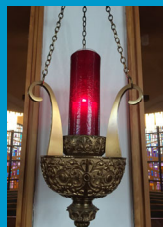

**SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT****GOD'S DELAY**

In times of great difficulties scoffers taunt us, "Where is God? Why hasn't your Lord come to save you now?"

And we of faith respond much in the same way as Peter did in today's second reading: the "delay" of the Lord's second coming is not any type of punishment or failure to keep the divine promise, but a loving sign of God's patience. God is

giving everyone the chance to seek repentance.

God does not make life more difficult. Rather, God lessens our burdens as once before for the Jewish exiles returning home to Judea after captivity in Babylon. It was God who personally led them, making a "straight highway" for them across the desert.

We join with our ancestors of faith, who hoped that they might see God's Chosen One before them and who eventually realized that the Lord was also walking with them side by side. Copyright © J. S. Paluch Co.

### Advent #2 – Peace Be With You

Last week, we began our Advent reflections exploring the theme of Hope. Hope carries through each of our Advent reflections, and more importantly, through the Advent season. In Advent, we realize that Jesus is our Hope, but we also hope for certain blessings that can be found in Jesus. This week, we explore the first of those blessings, Peace. During this Advent season, we hope for Peace.

When we think about Peace, we might first think of the more common definition of peace – an absence of war or conflict. This might be especially true at this time, as we are struggling to find this type of peace in our country. Between the political and social factions of our nations, there is much animosity and struggle.

However, the *Catechism* teaches us that “Peace is not merely the absence of war, and it is not limited to maintaining a balance of powers between adversaries. Peace is not merely the absence of war, and it is not limited to maintaining a balance of powers between adversaries. Peace cannot be attained on earth without safeguarding the goods of persons, free communication among [all people], respect for the dignity of persons and peoples, and the assiduous practice of fraternity. Peace is ‘the tranquillity [sic] of order.’ Peace is the work of justice and the effect of charity.” [CCC 2304]

As suggested by this definition from the Catechism, true Peace is only achieved through the right relationships of people with one another and with God. It is in these right relationships that we return to the original order of Creation.

When God had finished with Creation, “God looked at everything he had made, and found it very good.” [GN 1:31] However, people damaged their relationship with God through the Fall of Adam and Eve [GN 3], then quickly thereafter they damaged their relationship with one another, as evidenced by the story of Cain and Abel [GN 4:1-16]

What we hope for and celebrate in Advent is the beginning of the restoration of Peace, through the “Prince of Peace” [IS 9:5], Jesus Himself. God is the author of Peace, and Jesus, who is the Son of God, is the one who can really restore Peace to our fallen world. Therefore, what we look forward to and hope for during Advent is the coming of Peace through the Author and Prince of Peace, Jesus. Jesus began our restoration of Peace by reconciling us with God, through His life, ministry, Passion, Death and Resurrection. He also began our restoration of Peace by teaching us how to develop right relationships with one another, especially by His new commandment of love: “love one another as I love you.” [JN 15:12b]

What does this mean for us this Advent season? It means that we should not only *Hope* for Peace, but also that we should *work* for Peace. Advent is a great time for us to work toward restoring our relationship with God – through renewed devotion to prayer and the Sacraments. It is also a great time for us to work toward restoring our relationship with others – through communication, understanding, forgiveness, and reconciliation.

We will be distributing about 84 presents to the children at Holy Cross Catholic Preschool; 50 gifts to elderly residents at St. James government-subsidized housing in West Palm Beach; 50 gifts to senior residents at Villa Regina in West Palm Beach and 50 gifts to Villa Franciscan in Riviera Beach, both of which are subsidized by Catholic Charities, 25 or so handicapped people, 78 children through a local church outreach program, 10 to DePorres Place, 25 gifts to Hands Together of the Palm Beaches and some to several families we serve directly.

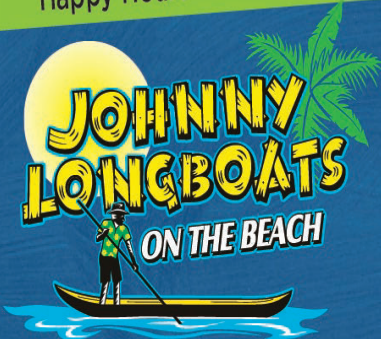

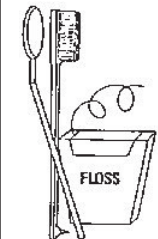
