A Look Back at the Beginning - #1

This past weekend, I had the difficult obligation to inform my dear Parish Family of St. Paul of the Cross that my time as Pastor would soon be coming to a close. For those who were present at Mass this weekend, you heard me announce that Bishop Rodriguez has asked me to become the new Pastor of St. Mark in Boynton Beach. While I am excited about the new opportunities that await me there, I will miss my St. Paul of the Cross Family terribly.

As such, I have been looking back on my time at St. Paul of the Cross fondly, and I have decided to take these last few weeks to remember some of the columns from those first years. The first installment is an excerpt from my very first column in January 2018, which is actually a quote from my remarks at the Mass of Installation as Pastor in October 2017:

As many of you know, I think our Catholic faith is beautiful. From the flowing rhythms of the liturgy to the eloquence of theology, from the uplifting praise of our music to the heartfelt words of our prayers, from the luminous images of our stained glass to the encouragement that comes from the statues and pictures of our saints, from the mysteries of the Trinity and the Eucharist to the history of the development of our Church, this faith is beautiful. But, today, there are two elements of our faith that evoke beauty for me more than all the others. Those two elements are the Church and hope.

One of the most beautiful parts of our faith is hope. In fact, we are a people of hope. We are a people of hope because that's what

Christ taught us to be. Christ gave us hope by His Passion, Death and Resurrection. We have hope in Christ because he gave us New Life in Him. So, many of the actions that we perform as a part of our faith are actions filled with hope. We have hope at the Baptism of a new baby – her new life cries out of the care of our Lord for all of us, even the littlest ones. We have hope at the wedding of a young couple. Their new life together reminds us of God's great gift of love. We even have hope at funerals. We have hope of a new life in Heaven for our loved one. I pray that this moment is a moment of hope for us all too, [...] that together, we have hope that the Holy Spirit will continue to lead our parish closer to the Lord and will inspire us to invite other people to join us as disciples of Christ.

Today, I believe that the beauty of our faith is also found in the Church, and what I mean by the Church is the Body of Christ, the people. I know that I have mentioned this before, but I am so grateful for the welcome that I received when I first entered this parish a little over a year ago. [**now 10 years ago**] [...] I always thank God for all of you who have been so supportive of my ministry here. Over and over again, I am awestruck by the beauty of the faith, hope and love of this Church, the people of St. Paul of the Cross Parish. May God be with us to guide us and bless us all.

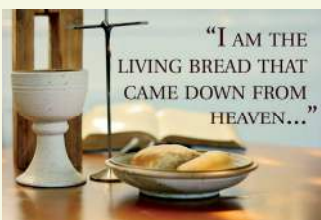

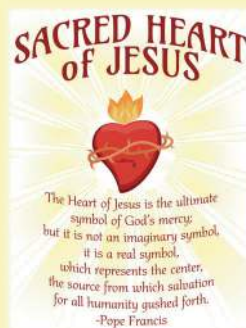

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ:

Next weekend, June 13/14, the Diocese of Palm Beach will collect funds for two vital causes: Black and Indian Missions and the Catholic Home Missions.
