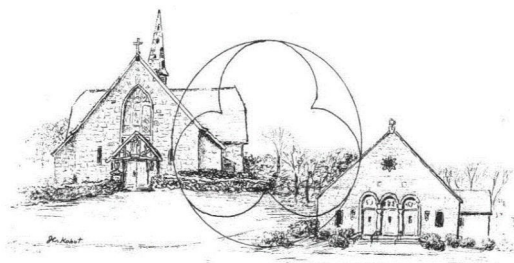

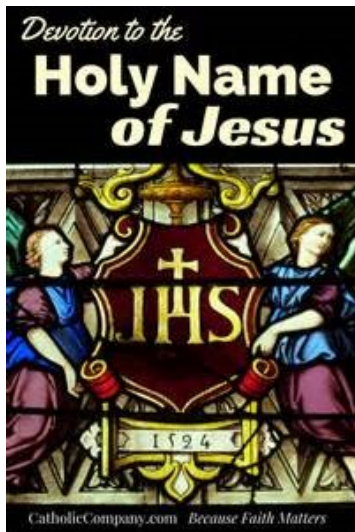

### Faith Formation Notes From the Religious Ed office

As we begin a new year, just a few reminders and calendar notes concerning religious education:

Please note that there are no Sunday classes (grades 1 – 5 and Confirmation) on January 14, because of the Martin Luther King Jr holiday weekend. Mass attendance is of course obligatory for all Catholics every Sunday or its vigil. Sunday morning: on the first Sunday of the month we celebrate Family Fellowship Sunday (in lieu of class). Please join us at the 8:30 Mass for a special mass with the children in mind, followed by a pancake breakfast after mass at the hall.

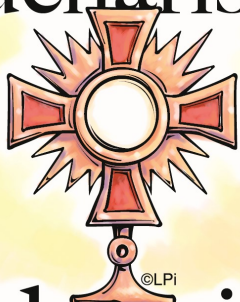

 storm. I was able to purchase a new snow  
 blower for each church thanks to your gener-  
 osity. Our old snow blowers are being repaired  
 and will be great back ups. Money well spent,  
 especially since I am doing plenty of shovel-  
 ing. Our monthly collection for maintenance  
 and utilities has been very helpful and I'm  
 very grateful for your generosity. Our heating  
 costs for mid-November to mid December- are  
 in the vicinity of \$4,500. We are doing all we
