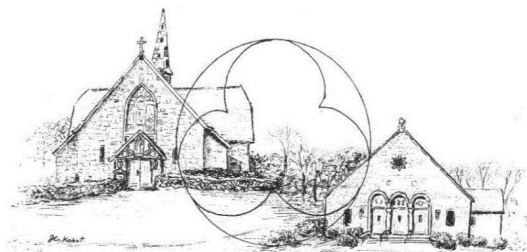

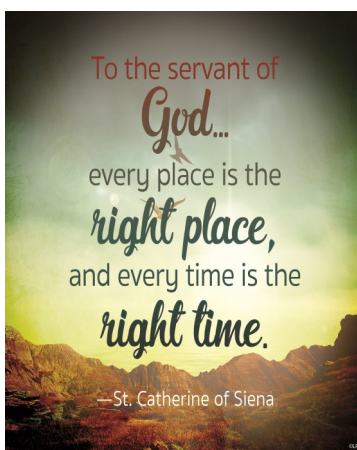

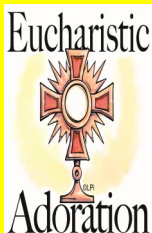

It has been encouraging to see our pastoral plan writing team making great progress. One of our first tasks was to write a vision statement. A statement that describes where we would like our parish to be in the future.

Here is a vision statement:

R—Relevant—Appropriate for current needs and circumstances.

T—Time bound—Clear date and period of time set for goal completion.
