Mandatory First Reconciliation/First Eucharist Parent Meeting





Note from the Pastor

As quickly as it came, it has gone. The Christmas Season ends on the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord. Jesus begins his public ministry and ends his "hidden years" with his baptism by John. Instead of being washed of sin in the waters of baptism, Jesus makes the waters holy. Jesus begins his public ministry at the age of 30, the age of a Rabbi or teacher. John the Baptist prepared his whole life for making ready the way of the Lord, preparing the people for Jesus coming by his preaching. John hands on the baton to his master and Jesus takes over the job of reconciling the human race to the Father by his paschal mystery—his suffering, death, and resurrection. Today the ministry of Jesus begins—a very important day in history.

Jesus's work, never ended. He continues to sanctify his disciples, by the sacraments he instituted. Jesus is still at work in the sacraments, making his people, his disciples Holy. Baptism is the first step on the journey, once we accept the Good News of the gospel.

We have been given a great treasure in the sacraments and in holy scripture. We need both to grow in the spiritual life. If you find sacred scripture too complicated or confusing, there is good news, pun intended, there is help available. We are going to be offering a video series on the Bible coming up on January 31, Thursday evenings from 6:30 till about 8pm. This series will walk us through the different books of the Bible that teach us salvation history. This is a great series that I've offered in many parishes I've served in. It is a great tool to learn our faith, and it is great for the beginner, and will certainly benefit the most avid scripture student. I recommend this series to everyone, it really makes learning the bible fun and interesting.

I look forward to sharing this adult faith formation opportunity with you all. More info below.
