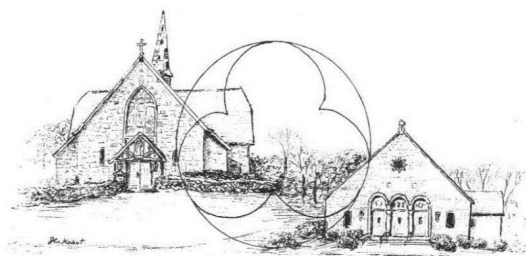

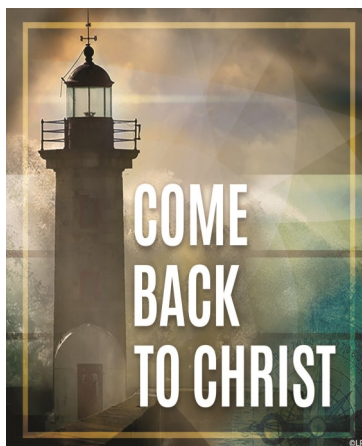

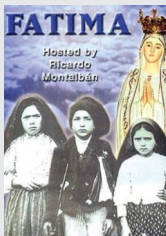

The Office of Faith Formation is looking for teachers for the following grades:

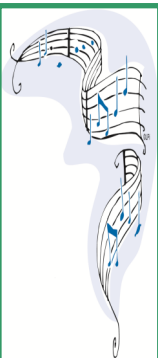
