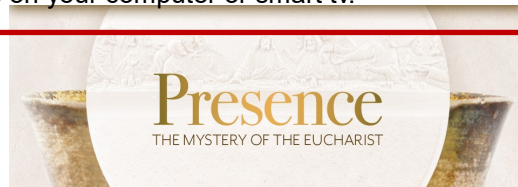
Please take advantage of this resource. There are many great movies and documentaries, as well as books to listen to.
