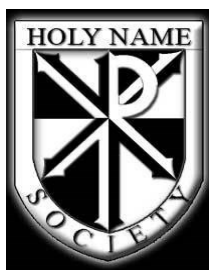
### **Special Collection—November 19-20 For Retired Religious Sisters**

## SOLEMNITY OF OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST KING OF THE UNIVERSE

The Church proclaims on this last Sunday of the Liturgical Year Jesus Christ, our Lord and Savior, is King of the Universe. Nothing in the way Christ presents himself in the gospels makes us think of the trappings or airs of royalty. In the crucifixion scene in today's gospel, which was anything but regal, the thief acknowledges Christ as the king that he is, saying, "remember me when you come into your kingdom." Do you look forward to entering the kingdom of heaven upon your death? The readings today convey all that Christ has done for each one of us – delivering us from the power of darkness, redeeming us, forgiving our sins and making it possible for us to enter the kingdom of God. That's the "good news" about Christ, our king, that needs to be shared! If you don't proclaim who Jesus is and what he has done for you, who will?
