






2022-2023 FAITH FORMATION NEXT CLASS — JANUARY 22

SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME January 15

In today's gospel, John the Baptist testifies that Jesus is the Son of God. Our faith and Sacred Scripture confirm this for us – Jesus is the Son of God. Pray today's Psalm with an open heart and open mind:

"Here am I, Lord; I come to do your will." What is God's will for us - for you? It is to speak the name of Jesus and tell of His work in your life. It is Jesus' will that you make disciples. Not everyone will do this the same way. Ask for the grace to see how you can testify – talk about - Jesus.
