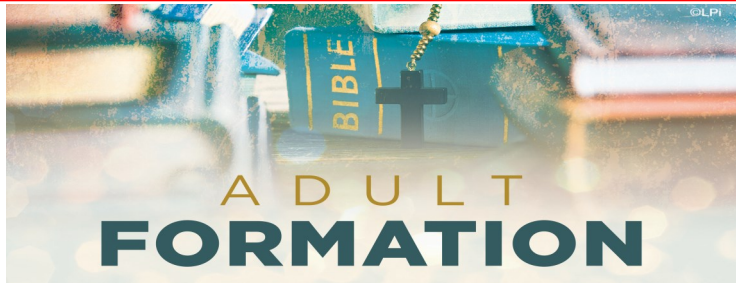

FIFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

February 5

The darkness and cold of winter still surround us making very relevant to our spiritual lives the theme of light and darkness in today's readings. In the first reading, Isaiah gives us the reminder that performing any work of mercy brings light into the darkness of our hearts and the world. Jesus, in speaking to the disciples and to us says, "*You are the light of the world.... your light must shine before others. . .*" As baptized children of God, we carry the light of Christ within us. In what ways do your words and actions shine before others, and make Christ visible? If they are not, what will you do this week to make the Christ light in you shine for others to see and thus bring light into the darkness that exists around you?
