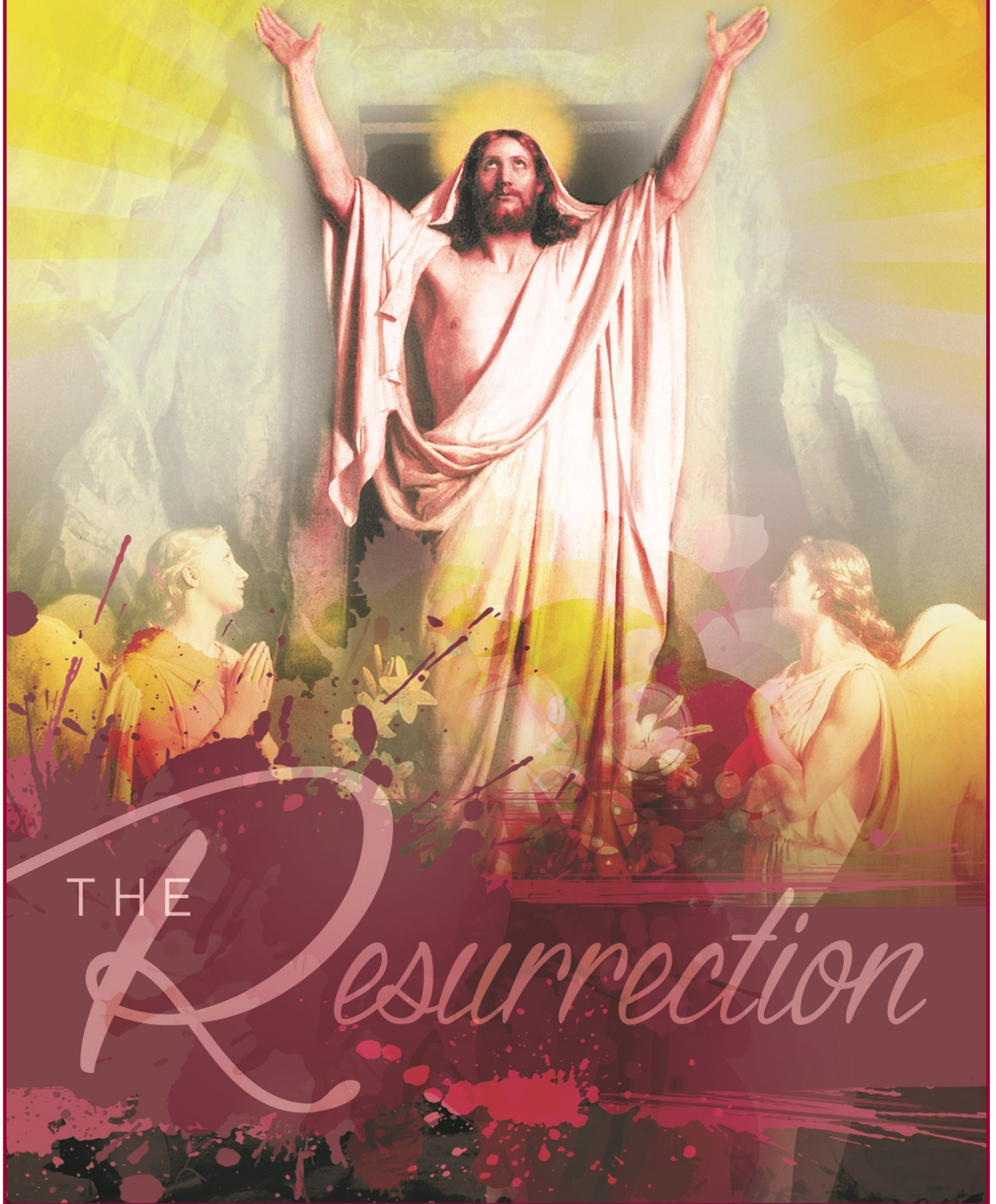

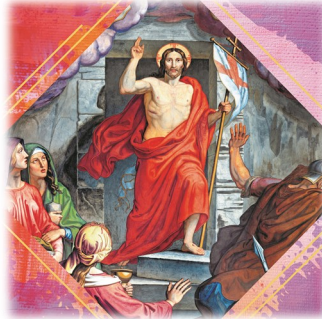


## Easter Message from Father Martin
