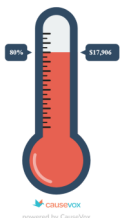

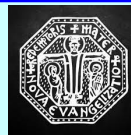
Project Rachel Post-Abortion Healing Retreat (May 6)

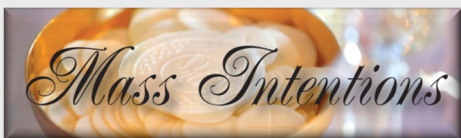
