

We are reminded in the Acts of the Apostles, that after the Resurrection "the word of God continued to spread, and the number of disciples... increased greatly." It may be good to ask ourselves - what keeps me from speaking about the ways God works in my life? What can I do to increase the number of disciples in this parish? You will also see that other live sessions are being offered throughout the diocese and may choose to attend one in a parish close to home.
