
We are a welcoming parish seeking to bring the Gospel of Jesus Christ to all who enter our doors.



Children receive altar server training and can begin serving alongside other servers at any of the weekend Masses (MBS 4:30 PM Saturday, 8:30 AM Sunday; OLGC 6:00 PM Saturday, 10:30 AM Sunday) one or two times a month based upon the child's availability. Altar servers are also invited to serve during special celebrations like First Communion, Confirmation, Christmas and Easter.
