# Evangelization FIFTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME July 16



Our readings present the image of the Word of God being sown as seeds upon field. "A sower went out to sow...." Listen to these readings with the mind and heart of an evangelizer. Is the soil of your soul receptive to the word of God that you hear? Do you believe that with God's grace, your words and action can bear fruit and bring someone closer to Jesus? Try to find ten minutes each day to read some Scripture. As you do that, pray that the seed of God's word will bear fruit within you.



July 16 The origins of this feast reach all the way back to the Old Testament. In the book of Kings, we read the story of the prophet Elijah. Much of his prayer, fasting, and public ministry occurred from Carmel, a mountain in Israel. Christian hermits—seeking solitude—made their homes on the mountain during the first millennium. Over time, the hermits assembled into a community and were given a Rule of Life. They named their church after Mary—Our Lady of Mount Carmel. Political upheaval forced the Carmelite order out of the Holy Land and into Europe, where they established monasteries for both men and women across the continent. Many great saints and doctors of the Church have come from the Carmelite order, including St. Teresa of Avila, St. John of the Cross, St. Therese of Lisieux, and St. Edith Stein. Our Lady of Mount Carmel. Pray for us!

## PROTECTING GOD'S CHILDREN LIVE TRAINING AVAILABLE FOR ADULTS

The Office of Child Advocacy of the Archdiocese of Boston is providing 'live' weekly PGC training via Zoom through Virtus.org throughout the summer. **Anyone who serves in ministry or as church volunteer MUST complete this one-time training.** If you have not already completed this training, or are considering serving our parish in any capacity, this is an opportunity to complete this training online.

To sign up, go to **Virtus.org**. Click the 'Live Training' tab, and then select 'Pre-register for an upcoming live training session' and you will find the schedule for adults to complete the PGC requirement. You will also see that other live sessions are being offered throughout the diocese and may choose to attend one in a parish close to home.

Children of Holy Trinity Parish who have received First Eucharist are invited to altar serve at parish Masses. Children receive altar server training and can begin serving alongside other servers at any of the weekend Masses (MBS 4:30 PM Saturday, 8:30 AM Sunday; OLGC 6:00 PM Saturday, 10:30 AM Sunday) one or two times a month based upon the child's availability. Altar servers are also invited to serve during special celebrations like First Communion, Confirmation, Christmas and Easter.
