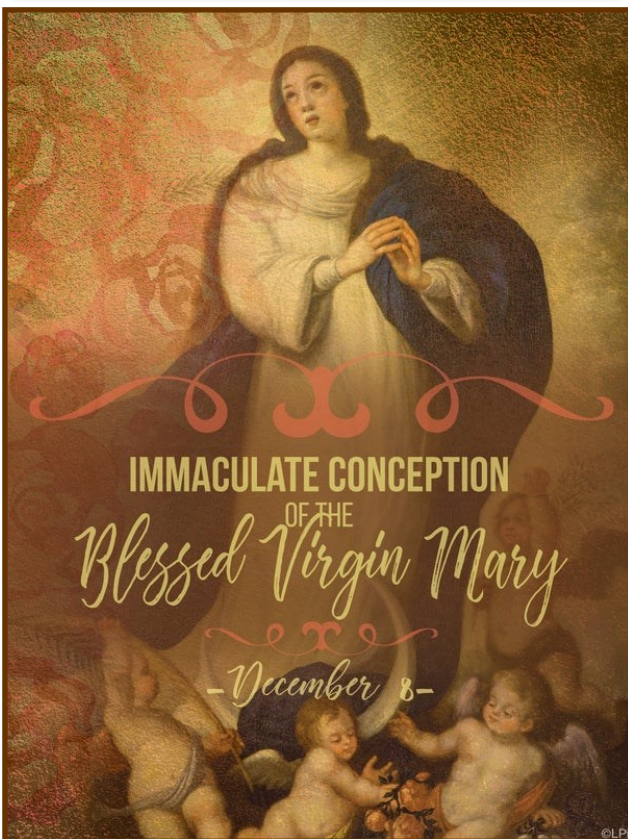
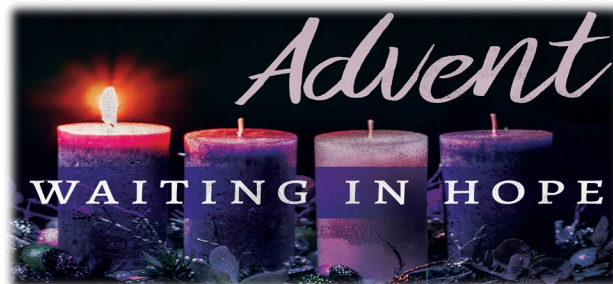

Children of Holy Trinity Parish who have received First Eu-
charist are invited to altar serve at parish Masses. Children
receive altar server training and can begin serving alongside
other servers at any of the weekend Masses (MBS 4:30 PM
Saturday, 8:30 AM Sunday; OLG 6:00 PM Saturday, 10:30
AM Sunday) one or two times a month based upon the
child’s availability. Altar servers are also invited to serve
during special celebrations like First Communion, Confirma-
tion, Christmas and Easter.

We believe that being an altar server brings children closer
to God, fosters a better understanding of Mass and is an im-
