

Note from the Pastor.

What a wonderful month May is! The grays of winter are replaced with all kinds of color as the earth seems to come back to life with another year of new growth. The Easter Season is also a time of grace and new growth if we are open to God's will in our lives. Please pray for our parish families that are celebrating First Holy Communions and Confirmations this month. It is my sincere prayer that many families will join the worshiping community and living the sacramental life. Our prayers and sacrifices can bring about miraculous conversions with the help of Our Lady of Good Counsel.

May is the month of Mary, our heavenly mother, given to us by Jesus from the cross through the apostle John: "Behold your Mother." Mary is "Mother of the Church" and our mother. Why not do something special for Mary during her month? Why not pray the rosary every day if you are not already doing so? Why not seek Mary's intercession? Mary's role is to bring us to Jesus, and to intercede for those who have recourse to her. Jesus' first public miracle was at the behest of Mary at a wedding feast in Cana, when she said: "They have no wine." An embarrassment for the young wedding couple.
