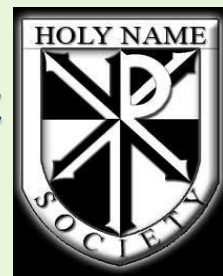

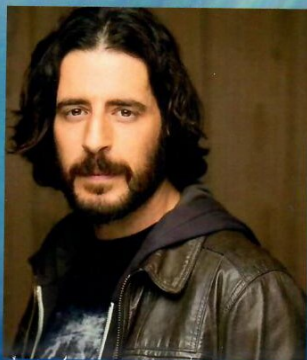

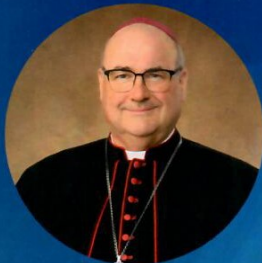
JOIN THE CHURCH CHOIR

Note from the Pastor

September is here and soon we will be starting up our religious education classes. Hopefully we will have more families coming to mass. We pray for an increase in the practice of the faith in our parish at every mass. As pastor, my biggest disappointment is the tiny percentage of young families who practice their faith. They are the future of the church. Please pray for them and encourage them. I'm not sure why so many people say no to the Lord's invitation to Holy Communion. Jesus offers us a very share in His divine life — the New Covenant in His Body and Blood, and the promise of eternal life for those who say yes to his invitation to be his disciple. Yet the majority of younger families in our parish choose not to participate, they have other priorities. Please pray for them and for me, that I might be a better pastor. I'm not sure what more you can offer people than what Jesus offers us, a share in his divine life, and the promise of eternal life. Who could say no to that? But the vast majority, perhaps 95% say no thank you, sports and other activities are more important. This calls to mind Luke 18:8b: "But when the Son of Man comes, will he find faith on earth?" Thank you to all who make the effort to live your faith and to please the Lord. You give me hope. Blessings to all.—Fr. Martin
