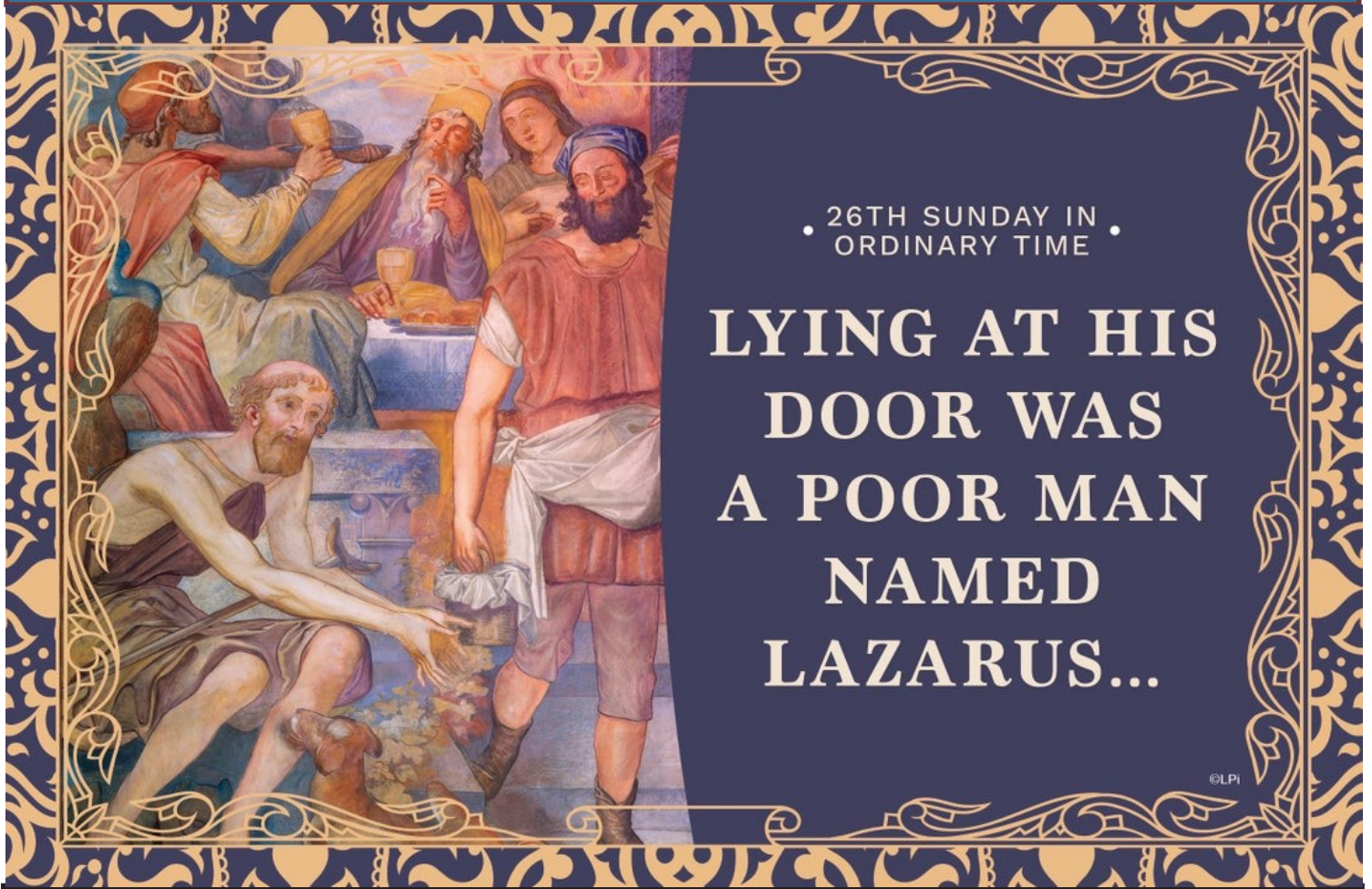

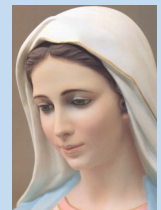

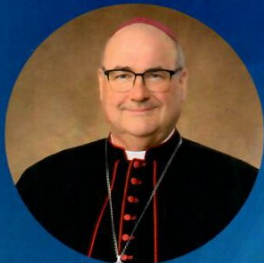
JOIN THE CHURCH CHOIR

The Word of the Lord

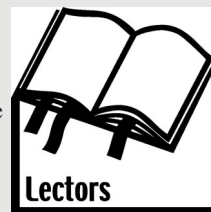
We are looking for more Lectors to proclaim the readings at mass.
