





As we enter the third week of Advent, we have only about 10 days left on our Advent journey. This weekend we celebrate Gaudete Sunday, rejoice Sunday! A message the world desperately needs to hear, with so much going on around us to distract us from that joy.


We do not rejoice because we believe Jesus came to bring heaven down to earth, rather, rather we rejoice because we know that Jesus came to open a path from earth into heaven. A path for us to follow, a path upon which he has shown us the way, for He told us: "I am the way, the truth and the life." When He becomes "our" way, our truth, and our life we can't help but rejoice, knowing that we are preparing to celebrate the greatest gift the world has known, the gift of God, the Word made flesh, the baby in the manger who is both fully human and fully divine, and who chose to dwell among us, to show us the way to the Father, in heaven.

We rejoice this day because we will soon celebrate his incarnation, his coming to us in the flesh, in humility, as a helpless baby. The all powerful, omnipotent Son of God, the Word made flesh, humbled himself to become completely dependent upon his mother Mary and foster father Joseph.

Is it any wonder, that Jesus as a man, would preach humility, and condemn pridefulness. If we want to heed the message of John the Baptist, "repent" – we too need humility, a virtue that allows us to see ourselves as we truly are before God: little, yet greatly loved by God, and that is why we have reason to rejoice. Advent is a time to prepare our hearts, and to give thanks to God for the gift of life, created in God's image and likeness, and therefore sacred, the dignity of which we won't fully comprehend until we are with God in his glory. A gift we do not deserve, but one that Jesus freely gives to those who seek Him.

So let us rejoice in the light of Christ, and prepare our hearts by living our faith to the fullest! God is good!
