



From the Pastor

Advent is coming to a close and soon we will celebrate the nativity of the Lord. At the Annunciation, the Word became flesh in the womb of the Blessed Virgin Mary, at the word of Mary, *“be it done unto me according to your word”*. *And Mary Conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit and the child to be born was called, Holy, the Son of God. In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things came to be through him, and without him nothing came to be. What came to be through him was life, and this life was the light of the human race; the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.*-

Advent is meant to be a season in which we take some time to reflect upon the greatest event in human history, Almighty God, the Word, the logos, who was with God from the beginning, through whom all things came to be, became a man in order to change the human race from within, and to show us the way to the Father. Jesus came to undo the fall of Adam and Eve. That is why theologians and doctors of the church call Jesus and Mary the new Adam and the new Eve who reconcile the original sin of Adam and Eve and make friendship with God once again possible. Through sin, Adam and Eve got expelled from the paradise of the Garden of Eden. The price of sin is death, and Jesus paid that price for us on the cross. Jesus took upon himself the sins of the world, of all time and nailed them to the cross, died and rose from the dead, victorious over sin and death itself. He deigned to communicate that victory to us through the sacraments he gave us. In baptism, we are washed clean of original sin of Adam and Eve and any personal sin if we are old enough to have sin when we are baptized. Through Holy Communion we are given a share in the Divine life of Christ, Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity, present all present in that little Host, a very share in the life of God, the Bread of life. How can anyone say no to the bread of life? I have to think, only because they “know not what they do”. Jesus offered the world salvation through faith in him, and much of the world rejected him. *“Remember, if they hate you, they hated me first.” A great light came into the world, but much of the world preferred darkness.* We are children of the light, we are blessed to be “the body of the Christ”, with Jesus as our head. We have received the promise of eternal life. *“whoever eats this bread shall live forever, for the bread I give is my flesh for the life of the world.”* Christmas is nigh, so let us rejoice in the New Born King. Born that we might have eternal life, and *eternal life is knowing God.* +
