



We are a welcoming parish seeking to bring the Gospel of Jesus Christ to all who enter our doors.



For the secular world, Christmas is over, Old Saint Nick has come and gone, but for us, Christmas continues, the Octave of Christmas is an eight day Solemnity. As a priest, we pray the Christmas day prayers, for eight days. Back in the year 567 the second council of Tours proclaimed twelve days of Christmas from Christmas to the Epiphany, and today, the Christmas **Season** extends until the Feast of the baptism of the Lord, this year, January 8th. Many Eastern Rite Catholics and Orthodox Christians, exchange gifts not on Christmas day, but on the twelve day, the Epiphany, when the magi, brought the Child Jesus **their** gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh.

Today, within the Solemnity of Christmas, the Octave of Christmas, we celebrate the Holy Family: Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, and by honoring the Holy Family, we honor all families. In a very real way, today is the feast day of the domestic Church- as Pope St. John Paul II called the family. For every family, he said, is the Church, in miniature, the family reflects an image of God, who is family, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, with a human mother, Mary, mother of the Church. Today we Rejoice in the great gift of family.

We are all called to imitate the Holy Family, to be holy, to be part of holy families. What the Church calls the universal call to holiness. May the Eucharist we share empower us all to be Holy in our lives. +
