





Today the church celebrates the Epiphany, the “great revealing” of the Christ Child to the non-Jewish Gentile world. The Magi or Three Kings of the East, follow a star to Bethlehem and find the Holy Family and new born King. The heavens themselves reveal that the universe is forever changed with the coming of the Savior of the world.
