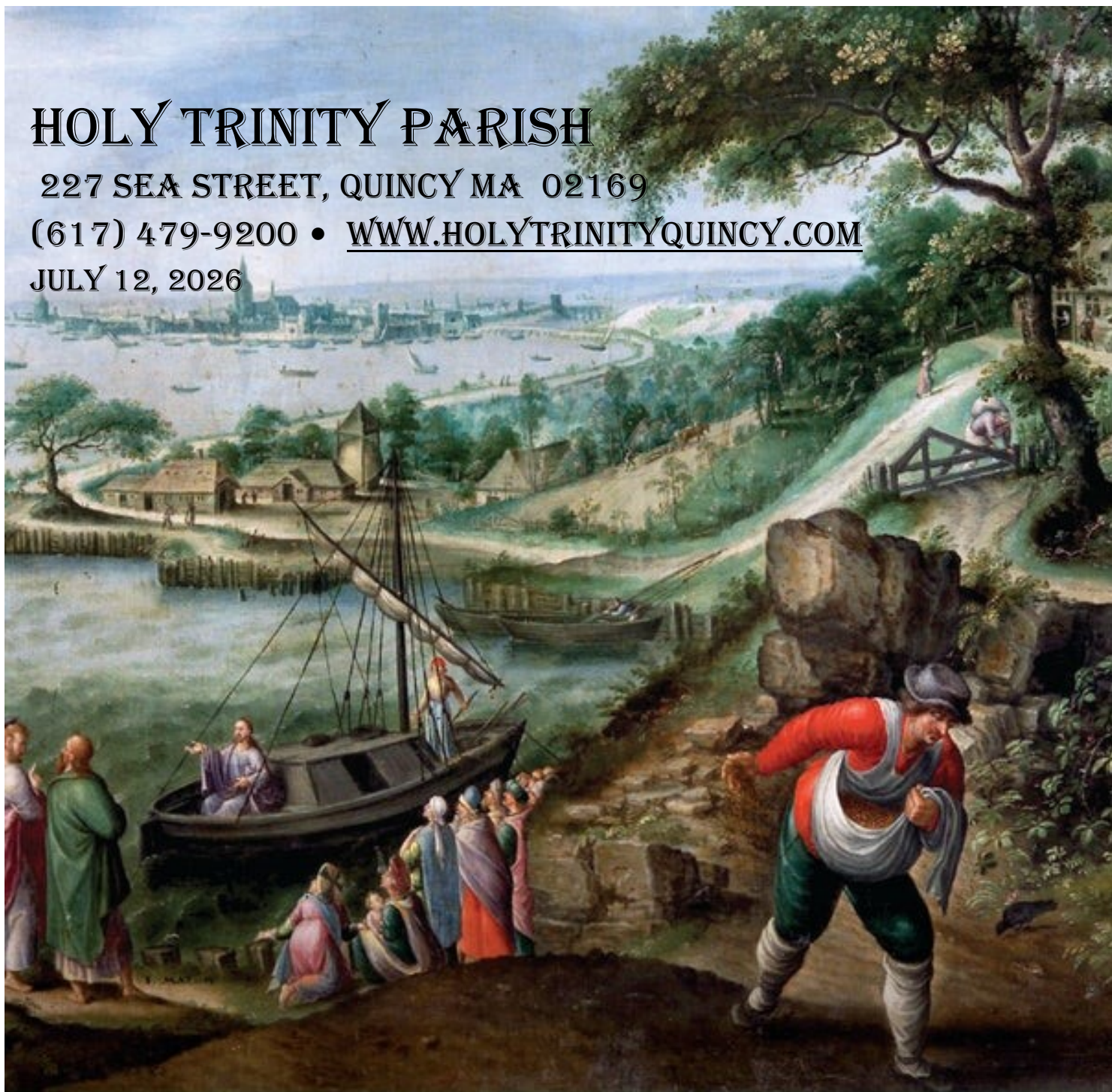

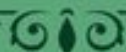

Please Help Stop Physician Assisted Suicide Legislation

Reasons to oppose: A Deadly Mix with Our Profit-Driven Health Care System, Some patients in Oregon and California have received word that their health insurance will pay for assisted suicide but will not pay for treatment that may sustain their lives. Once lethal drugs have been prescribed, assisted suicide laws have no requirements for assessing the patient's consent, competency, or voluntariness. Who would know if the drugs are freely taken since there is no supervision or tracking of the drugs once they leave the pharmacy and no witnesses are required at the time of death? Despite a reporting system designed to conceal rather than detect abuses, reports of undue influence have nonetheless surfaced in Oregon. Elder abuse is considered a major health problem in the United States, No Psychiatric Evaluation or Treatment Required, pain Not the Primary Issue. There are many more reasons to oppose....
