From the Parochial Vicar's Desk

Today's readings are...confusing. The reading from Genesis feels like it came out of one of my fantasy novels, regarding sacrifice, trances, and

visions from God. Paul speaks about citizenship in heaven and how our bodies are transformed. We finally have the transfiguration of Jesus, showing Christ in his glory. All of our readings have a level of mysticism about them; to help us understand the journey our faith takes us on.

Following the theme of last week's readings where Jesus understands yet overcomes the temptation of the world, our readings show us a better way to live, a new path forward. We are to be transfigured by the Trinity in our lives. By the transfiguration (transformation in the spiritual realm) we focus on the reality of God instead of the reality of the world. To be transfigured by God means to empty ourselves of our own wants and desires and to be filled by the grace of God. This takes place in our daily prayer life, the sacraments, and the devotions we bring to God. This does not mean we neglect our daily responsibilities, but enhance them through the inspiration God gives to us in our lives.

We must give up believing that we can "figure" God out and rather let God into our lives. This means being willing to give God our fears, our doubts, and our misery. Only by this daily and constant act of humility can God transfigure us as we attempt to do his will. I do not have the solutions to the many issues of our day, from our Church to our nation. I am simply trying to follow God and do his will in the time I have. May we follow the example of Paul and truly believe in the citizenship of heaven, the promise of the cross and the arrival of our savior Jesus Christ both now and In Christ, Fr. Aaron forever.






