

ON THE 14TH SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME

"Come to me all you who are burdened and labored; I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am meek and humble of heart; and you will find rest for yourselves. For my yoke is easy, and my burden light."
