

ANATOMY OF OUR COLLECTION

Why do we attend St. Alphonsus Liguori? Ultimately, it is the liturgy that draws us together. Although the liturgy is the most important part of our spiritual lives, spending for the Worship Ministry represents only 2% of our annual operating budget.

The **Body and Blood of Christ**, tangible in the form of bread and wine, is the most important expense budgeted through the Worship Ministry. It is also responsible for purchasing books and missals used at Mass, both on the altar and in the pews.

You may have had occasion to visit the Blessed Sacrament Chapel or the Marian Shrine to light a candle for a special intention. These candles and others used in the church are recurring Worship Ministry monthly expenses, as are the plants and flowers that beautify our altar each week.

Scheduling liturgical ministry volunteers is crucial to this ministry, and in an effort to assist the parish staff, a software program is implemented. This software must be licensed, which is an invisible cost.

LITURGY AND LIFE

A colleague of mine recently posted on Facebook about a bumper sticker observed on the way to church. It read "Choose the Bread of Life or you will be toast." That is pretty much what Jesus says in today's Gospel, although St. Mark states it this way:

"Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved; whoever does not believe will be condemned." (Mark 16:16)

The mission to proclaim the Gospel to the whole world is given by Jesus to his disciples in the verse before the abovementioned. He states:

"Go into the whole world and proclaim the gospel to every creature." (Mark 16:15)

But who is responsible to inform the people of today about Jesus and eternal life? We are. Not them, not those people over there, but us – his disciples in this age. As we read further in this Gospel, Jesus will leave his disciples the "tools of the trade" such as speaking new languages and healing the sick.

Jesus leaves us the "tools of the trade" at Mass. We hear the witnesses to the Paschal Mystery in the readings, so that in turn we may witness to others. We receive the grace of the Holy Eucharist to nourish and fortify us in our mission to the world. And finally, at the Dismissal we are sent forth to "Go and announce the Gospel of the Lord."

And for our efforts may those who hear our witness choose the Bread of Life over toast!

Jesus asks us to be witnesses of God's presence in our midst, to be agents of hope, to be prophets of compassion and peace. We are called to continue Jesus' work to teach, to witness, and to heal in our own small corners of the world, to hand on the story that has been handed on to us about Jesus and his Gospel of love and compassion.

There will be a training for Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion (EMHC) on Sunday, May 20 at 9:15 AM and 6:15 PM in preparation for the commissioning the weekend of Corpus Christi, June 2/3.

We need more EMHC so that the procession at Holy Communion is more efficient. Please prayerfully consider participating in this very special ministry. Ministers are trained and commissioned to assist the priest in the distribution of the Body and Blood of Christ during Communion and in the purification of the Sacred Vessels after Mass. Ministers distribute Holy Communion to the faith community under the form of Bread and Wine.

Many individuals' first response when asked to be an Extraordinary Minister is "Oh no, not me, I could never." Usually it is not an issue of competence, but more often, a feeling of unworthiness. Our faith tells us we were made whole by our baptism of being full heirs with Christ. Who among us has the power to undo what God has done? True, we do need a sense of humility about ourselves.

Nevertheless, if we are worthy to receive Communion, we are then also worthy to be Ministers of Holy Communion.

OUR MARIAN SHRINE'S GOLD CROWN




A coronation is a form of reverence frequently shown to images of the Blessed Virgin Mary, having become widespread by the end of the 16th Century. The *Order of Crowning* of an image of the Blessed Virgin is an official, liturgical act, published in 1987 by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops.

The gold crown which adorns Our Lady of Perpetual Help on special occasions is the only one of its kind in the world! While carving the image of Our Lady in 2015, the master woodcarvers created two matching crowns of linden wood. One of the crowns was taken to a company in Baarerstrasse, Switzerland, that had innovated a new gilding technology in the field of precious coatings. It was the first time it would ever be applied to this type of surface.

Trinity Church Supply, the collaborator of our shrine, presented the crown as a gift to St. Alphonsus Liguori Parish in early 2016.
