LITURGY AND LIFE

You can still visit the Town of Cana. It is west of the Sea of Galilee in modern-day Israel. On the map it is called Kafr Kanna. The Catholic Church located there is known as the Franciscan Wedding Church at Cana. It is visited by hundreds of pilgrims each year. In 2014, my wife and I were two of those pilgrims. During Mass at this church, we and another couple from our pilgrimage group renewed our wedding vows at the invitation of the parish priest.

Two thousand years earlier, Jesus had made himself manifest to his disciples in this geographical location. He changed the water into wine a lot of water into a lot of wine, as you can see by the stone vessel artifact in the picture.

But that did not happen on this June day in 2014. Instead, Jesus made himself manifest to all the faithful present by changing our offering of Bread and Wine into his Body and his Blood.

We had arrived at Cana to recall the story told in today's Gospel, and found the Lord where Faith meets history.
