LITURGY AND LIFE

We have all heard, and perhaps even uttered, the saying “two’s company, three’s a crowd.” The implication is that two people in the group want to have a relationship to the exclusion of a third person. Evidently, God does not mind being a crowd. Christianity professes one unified God with three persons - the Holy Trinity.

We can search the Bible, both Old and New Testaments and never find the term “Trinity” or any of its derivatives. So how do we know our one God is comprised of three persons?

There are many New Testament texts that infer God the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit without explicitly saying Trinity. Today’s Gospel is such an example. Jesus refers to the Holy Spirit as the “Spirit of truth” and goes on to say, *“Everything that the Father has is mine; for this reason I told you that he [Holy Spirit] will take from what is mine and declare it to you.”* (John 16:15)

This unique relationship is where the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit possess each other in a unity that is difficult, if not impossible to comprehend. Instead we trust in our hearts.

We actually profess our belief in the Holy Trinity whenever we make the Sign of the Cross. The Sign of the Cross is a simple gesture with great significance. We sign the cross from head to breast, left shoulder to right shoulder, as we advocate the Holy Trinity. While doing this simple action, we proclaim the mystery of faith in the death and resurrection of Jesus, and we profess our faith in the Triune God.

The Sign of the Cross is a sacramental, a sacred sign that bears a certain resemblance to the sacraments *“by means of which spiritual effects are signified and obtained through the prayers of the Church.”* (CCC)

Perhaps three isn’t really a crowd after all. Our Triune God does not seem to mind.

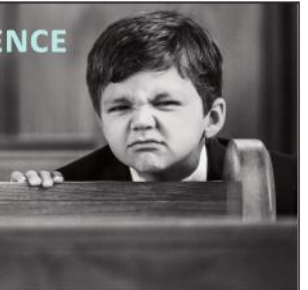
PRAY FOR OUR YOUTH AND CHAPERONES

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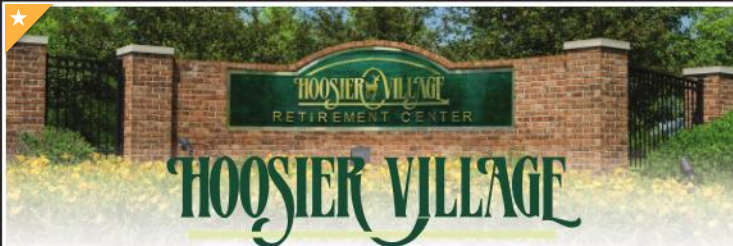
