

Venerable Eusebio Francesco Chini, S.J., known as Father Kino, was born in the Holy Roman Empire in 1645. At 20 years old, he joined the Society of Jesus and then became a priest in 1677. He served as a missionary and built missions and ranches extending from Mexico to present-day California and Arizona.

A skilled cartographer, Fr. Kino drew maps of the Gulf of California and Baja, California. These maps remained the most accurate maps of this region for over 150 years! He encountered tribes in his travels and developed relationships with them, trading seeds, plants, and livestock. In fact, his original herd of 20 cattle that he and his fellow Jesuits transported to establish their missions grew during his lifetime to 70,000 animals as he sold and traded them. This won him the title of Arizona's first rancher.

Fr. Kino was also an astronomer and mathematician. In his first attempt to travel to the Americas, he missed his boat, which caused him to spend a year in southern Spain. He spent the year observing a comet, later known as Kirch's comet, and published his findings in the Exposición Astronómica de el Cometa, or the Astronomical Exhibition of the Comet.

After establishing missions, championing natives' rights, and constructing supply villages to provide for settlements, Fr. Kino died in 1711. He is honored in the U.S. and Mexico with landmarks named after him. Pope Francis advanced the cause of Venerable Eusebio Francesco Chini — Father Kino — on July 11, 2020.

BE WITH CHRIST

The lay practice of perpetual adoration formally began in France in 1226. To celebrate a victory, King Louis VII of France asked the Bishop of Avignon to have the Blessed Sacrament exposed in the chapel. The throng of adorers was so great that the bishop decided to have adoration continue.

During the Middle Ages, more began to adore. At first, the custom was to worship the host reserved in the tabernacle. Eventually, some came to the devotion with the tabernacle doors open. Later still, exposition of the host became normal.

The practice spread and culminated in the creation of the Feast of Corpus Christi in 1264. The feast itself, now celebrated in June, helped spread the devotion.

It wasn't until the Council of Trent that perpetual adoration developed internationally. During the Protestant Reformation, church lootings were common. Faithful Catholics kept a loving vigil before Him around the clock.
