



St. Pedro Calungsod was born around the year 1654 in the Philippines. Early in life, Pedro developed a devout faith. At a young age, he volunteered to accompany Jesuit missionaries to Guam, and went there with Jesuit missionary Diego Luis de San Vitroes at the age of 14. Calungsod's mission was to catechize the natives — specifically the Chamorro people.

During his mission, many people were baptized. In a short period of time, Calungsod learned Spanish and developed relationships with the locals. Despite harsh conditions, a difficult-to-navigate island, and a lack of supplies, he managed to catechize.

While in Tumon in 1672, a criminal named Choco began to spread rumors. He claimed the baptismal water used by the missionaries was poisonous and was the reason that some sickly infants died. This rumor sank its teeth and inspired persecution of the missionaries.

Chief Matapang believed the rumors and forbade baptism. Secretly, at his wife's request, the missionaries went ahead and baptized their children. This enraged the chief and roused him to enlist villagers to kill the missionaries. It is said that Calungsod had a chance to escape but instead did his best to defend San Vitroes. Calungsod was martyred at the age of 17.

Pope John Paul II approved the martyrdom and beatification of St. Pedro Calungsod on December 19, 2011. Pope Benedict canonized him on October 21, 2021, on world Mission Sunday— 340 years after his death.

THE 7 LAST DAYS — A SERVICE OF SHADOWS APRIL 7 | PRELUDE AT 8:00 PM, SERVICE AT 8:15 PM

From his triumphant entry into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday, to his burial in the tomb, the Service of Shadows is an opportunity to reflect on the seven last days of Jesus' earthly life.

Join us as we retell this story through a series of readings and



hymns. With each step, a candle is extinguished until the church is plunged into darkness, symbolic of Jesus' three days in the tomb. The next light to enter the church will be the Paschal candle at the Easter Vigil. The service will be led by SAL cantors, the adult choir, and a chamber ensemble.





A LETTER FROM BISHOP DOHERTY | MARCH 20, 2023


On March 20, 2023, I met with the priests of the diocese and Uniting in Heart leadership team at the Saint Joseph Retreat & Conference Center. Proposals to our diocesan pastoral plan were shared based on the consultation that has been ongoing since January. The motivation of our consultations has been to respect the capacities of our priests, and to better

enable them to shepherd God's people.

A Holy Hour was intentionally included in the agenda to allow everyone an opportunity to pray through the proposals and then share thoughts after lunch. Some good interventions were made and they will be looked at and discerned further. However, we have moved beyond the consultation phase of this process and we are now making final plans for implementation. A more formal, detailed plan will be communicated to the diocese as soon as possible.
