

Venerable Cornelia Peacock Connelly was born in Philadelphia in 1809. She met Pierce Connelly, an Episcopal cleric, and joined the Episcopal church. When she was 22, they got married, moved south, had five children, and converted to Catholicism. Pierce dreamed of continuing his priesthood but his marriage prevented it. He created a plan: if he and Cornelia agreed to separate and live celibate lives, Rome would let him be a priest.

In 1844, their plan was accepted; however, this was conditional upon Cornelia becoming a religious sister. He entered the priesthood and she stayed with the Society of the Sacred Heart, intending to enter the congregation once her kids were older. Instead, she founded The Society of

the Holy Child Jesus and Pope Gregory
invited her to begin this congregation
in England.

Before the move, Pierce visited regularly. Due to a restriction by her patron, he removed the children from her care, banned communication, and placed them in boarding schools.

Later, He left the priesthood, returned to the Episcopal faith, and asked Cornelia to return as his wife. When she refused, he sued but gave up after she appealed.

She is remembered as a woman of her word who stood her ground to defend those in need, including herself. She led her ministries with the joy of the Holy Spirit before dying in England in 1870 and was declared Venerable on June 13, 1992.

Happy Easter!


Easter is one of the most joyful times of the year, and this year, we have so much to celebrate!


