




Venerable Maria Consuelo Soledad Sanjurjo Santos was born on November 15, 1892, in Puerto Rico. By the time she was nine, both parents had passed and her extended family placed her in a boarding school run by the Servants of Mary, Ministers to the Sick. She befriended the Sisters and learned about their way of life. Maria was so attracted to the religious life that she entered the congregation as a postulant when she turned 16.

The Servants of Mary didn't have any formation houses in Puerto Rico, so Maria began postulancy in Madrid. After four years, she went to Cuba and took vows under her new name, Maria Soledad, in 1921. After 18 years, she became Mother Superior to a few houses and was appointed the Provincial Superior of the Antilles. She then founded communities all over and began a novitiate program in Ponce, Puerto Rico.

After 40 years at her congregation's headquarters, Mother Maria Soledad moved the Provincial House to Puerto Rico in 1962. Cuba had become unstable and she concluded that it would be safer for the Sisters to continue work in Puerto Rico instead. Following her heart attack, she completed her time as Provincial Superior and went on to embrace a simple life.

After 62 years of consecrated life, Mother Maria Soledad died on April 23, 1973, in San Juan. Pope Francis gave her recognition on January 15, 2019, and was named Venerable.


