



Servant of God Chaplain Emil Kapaun was born in 1916 on a farm in Pilsen, Kansas. He was ordained in 1940 and served at his home parish. In 1944, he entered the army as part of the Chaplain Corps and served in Asia. In 1949, after a brief break for college, he re-enlisted and went to Japan.

Kapaun and his division were ordered to repel North Korea's invasion of South Korea. During these months, Kapaun risked his life for others. He prayed with his division, offered confessions and baptisms, and said Mass from an improvised altar set up on the front end of a Jeep. When the PVA— the Chinese People's Volunteer Army— attacked the division, some troops retreated, but Kapaun stayed behind with the 800 men left. He personally saved over 40 lives before he and others were taken prisoner.

During his time as a POW, Fr. Kapaun spent every waking hour serving those he was with. Despite developing pneumonia, dysentery, and a blood clot, Fr. Kapaun still said Mass and served until he was too weak. He died on May 23, 1951, and was buried by friends on a hill marked with stones.

Kapaun was awarded a Medal of Honor, a Bronze Star, a Purple Heart, and the highest military award in the Republic of Korea: The Taegeuk Order of Military Merit. In 1992, Pope John Paul II named him a Servant of God. In January 2022, the Vatican announced that it was considering declaring Fr. Kaupan a martyr, although his miracles are still under investigation. If granted, it would speed up his canonization.




