

Venerable Pierre Toussaint was born into slavery in 1766 in Haiti and raised Catholic. He and his sister, Rosalie, were brought to New York City in 1787. Upon arriving, Pierre apprenticed with one of the city's leading hairdressers. He learned quickly and began doing the hair of rich women all over New York. When his enslaver died, Pierre voluntarily supported the enslaver's widow until she remarried. He then purchased the freedom of his sister and was freed in 1807.

In 1811, Toussaint purchased the freedom of Marie-Rose Juliette Noel — now known as Servant of God Marie-Rose Juliette Toussaint — and they married. When Rosalie died, they adopted her daughter Euphemia and raised her as their own. The family sheltered children and purchased a house where they supported orphaned boys, giving them educations, helping them learn trades, and setting them up with jobs.

Along with this philanthropic work, Pierre continued as a hairdresser to support his family. He died two years after Juliette in 1853 at the age of 87.

When the investigation into the cause for sainthood started, Pierre was exhumed and reinterred. He is the first layman to be honored by burial in the crypt below the main altar of Old St. Patrick's, an honor usually reserved for the archbishops of New York. He was declared Venerable by Pope John Paul II in 1996.


Christina loves making connections with people, so introduce yourself! As your sister in Christ, she looks forward to walking with



A SPIRITUAL APPROACH TO TEMPORAL CHANGE

The following is an excerpt from an article from the June 18 edition of The Catholic Moment by Colin May.

Humans dislike change—we crave stability and continuity. We become dependent on habits and routines...But when it comes to our spiritual growth, we need to change; we need to become more Christ-like. As the old saying goes, "no pain, no gain." Change is essential and something that we are constantly called to do in the Gospels. Jesus tells us that our hearts must change to bring us closer to God's love.

Change is challenging. We cannot simply move past things sometimes—change does take work. It takes sacrifice or humility. It can enable us to feel the loss or the emptiness, which also brings us closer to those who are sick, homeless, addicted, depressed, hungry, or marginalized; those, as St. Mother Teresa noted, who are "the poorest of the poor."

Our Church in the diocese is facing significant challenges; with that comes the need for change and modification. With challenges and change also come opportunities. For us, this includes reaching out to our neighbors through new evangelization strategies, physical space and geographical changes to accommodate these new realties, and moving our "favorite" pastors and priests. But this occasion enables our Church's mission of spreading the Good News and will bring us all closer to the Trinity, as long as we open our hearts.

The Hebrew word for change is mûwr—it also means "to alter" or "to exchange." Giving up our own desires and opening up our hearts to the changes that are to be announced for the diocese is an important part of being a believer. We must exchange our personal needs for those of our brothers and sisters; we must alter our expectations to ensure that we are willing and happy givers; and we must want to bring the hope of the Gospel to others in and through ways that we may not understand. That is the beauty of our faith.

Let us pray for the strength to welcome and be open to the changes in our diocese, and across the Universal Church, that are needed to bring more people together in the love of our Lord, Jesus Christ.
