



Thomas Frederick Price was born in North Carolina in 1860. As a child, he was mentored by many parish priests who served the church he attended. Upon graduating high school, he pursued the priesthood.

In 1877, Thomas started at St. Charles College before joining St. Mary's Seminary in Baltimore. He was ordained in North Carolina in 1886

Early in his priesthood, he started an orphanage whose success paved the way for opening a training house for local missionaries. This house became the Regina Apostolorum, a preparatory seminary focused on formation for missionaries. Later, Thomas met Fr. James Anthony Walsh and together, they purchased property in New York to begin the Catholic Foreign Mission Society of America, known today as Maryknoll.

In 1918, the seminary prepared their first trip overseas. Thomas accompanied them to China while Fr. Walsh stayed back. In China, Thomas became ill and traveled to Hong Kong for medical care. By the time he reached St. Paul's Hospital, run by the Sisters of St. Paul de Chartres, he was found to have a severe case of appendicitis. Despite several operations, he died in 1919. He was originally buried in Hong Kong but transferred to the Maryknoll Cemetery in 1936 and was then interred in the crypt below Maryknoll Seminary Chapel

alongside Fr. Walsh in 1955.


