Rose-Philippine Duchesne was born in France in 1769 to a wealthy family. As a child, she felt called to join the Society of the Sacred Heart, even though her family opposed it. In order to join, she convinced an aunt to join her on a trip to the Visitation of Holy Mary order's monastery. Once there, she joined, and her aunt went home to break the news. She made final vows during the French Revolution.

During the revolution, many religious orders were disbanded or persecuted. However, Sr. Rose-Philippine refused to abandon her calling and continued in secret.

Inspired by missionaries, Sister Rose-Philippine accepted an invitation to open schools in the U.S. In 1818, the first Sacred Heart school outside of Europe opened in Missouri. Despite the obstacles of living on a frontier, Sister Rose-Philippine opened schools, taught girls how to read, and ministered to the needy.

It wasn't until Rose-Philippine was 72 that her wish to serve Native Americans was granted. The Jesuit head of a mission insisted she join him in opening a school for the Potawatomi in Kansas. Sick and frail, she stayed with the tribe for a year, spending hours in contemplation, which earned her the nickname, Quah-kah-ka-num-ad: "Woman-Who-Prays-Always."

She died in 1852 at the age of 83. In 1988, St. Pope John Paul II declared Rose-Philippine Duchesne a saint.

EXCUSE OUR MESS!

Earlier in the year, Fr. Travis spoke about the repairs needed to the church building's fire suppression system. **Repairs are scheduled to begin November 13 and continue until further notice.** Father Travis addresses the situation in a recent letter to the parish. This letter is the insert in this week's bulletin; it may also be viewed by visiting our website.

As repairs progress, the church building will undergo various changes. For safety reasons, the church building is inaccessible Monday through Friday between the hours of 7:00 am - 4:00 pm. Therefore, location changes for Daily Mass and other ministries or groups are as follows:

- **Daily Masses on Weekdays** will be held in Parish Hall, Monday - Friday, at its normally-scheduled times.
- **Adoration in the Adoration Chapel** will be held in the chapel beginning at 4:00 pm, Monday - Friday, excluding days when repairs are taking place in the Chapel.
- **Confessions on Wednesday evenings** will be heard in Parish Hall.
- **The Blessed Sacrament Chapel** will be locked between 7:00 am - 4:00 pm, Monday through Friday
- **Saturday and Sunday Masses, Confessions, and Adoration** will maintain their usual time and locations.

We appreciate your ability to adapt and willingness to accommodate these temporary schedule changes. If there is a change to a ministry schedule, you will be contacted by the Volunteer Leader or the Staff Liaison concerning the change.

MEET THE CANDIDATES AND CATECHUMENS!

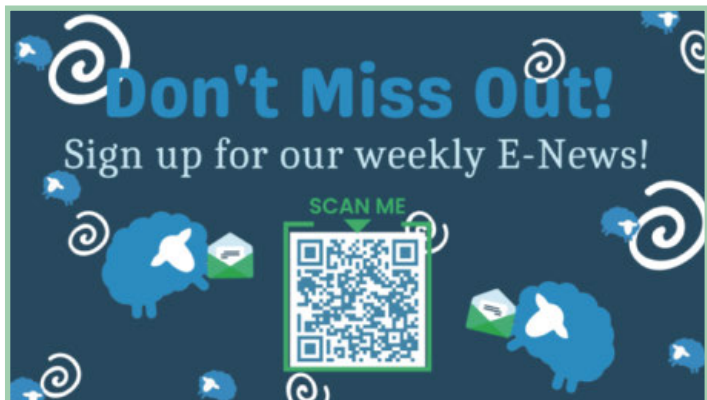
Until they enter the Church, we will feature candidates and catechumens who are in discernment and participating in the RCIA process. Please pray for them, their sponsors, and their families!

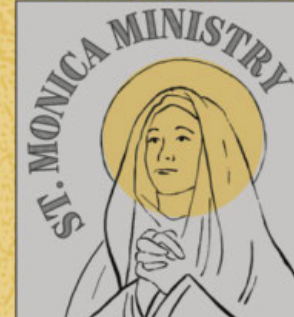

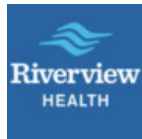

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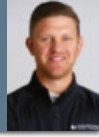
