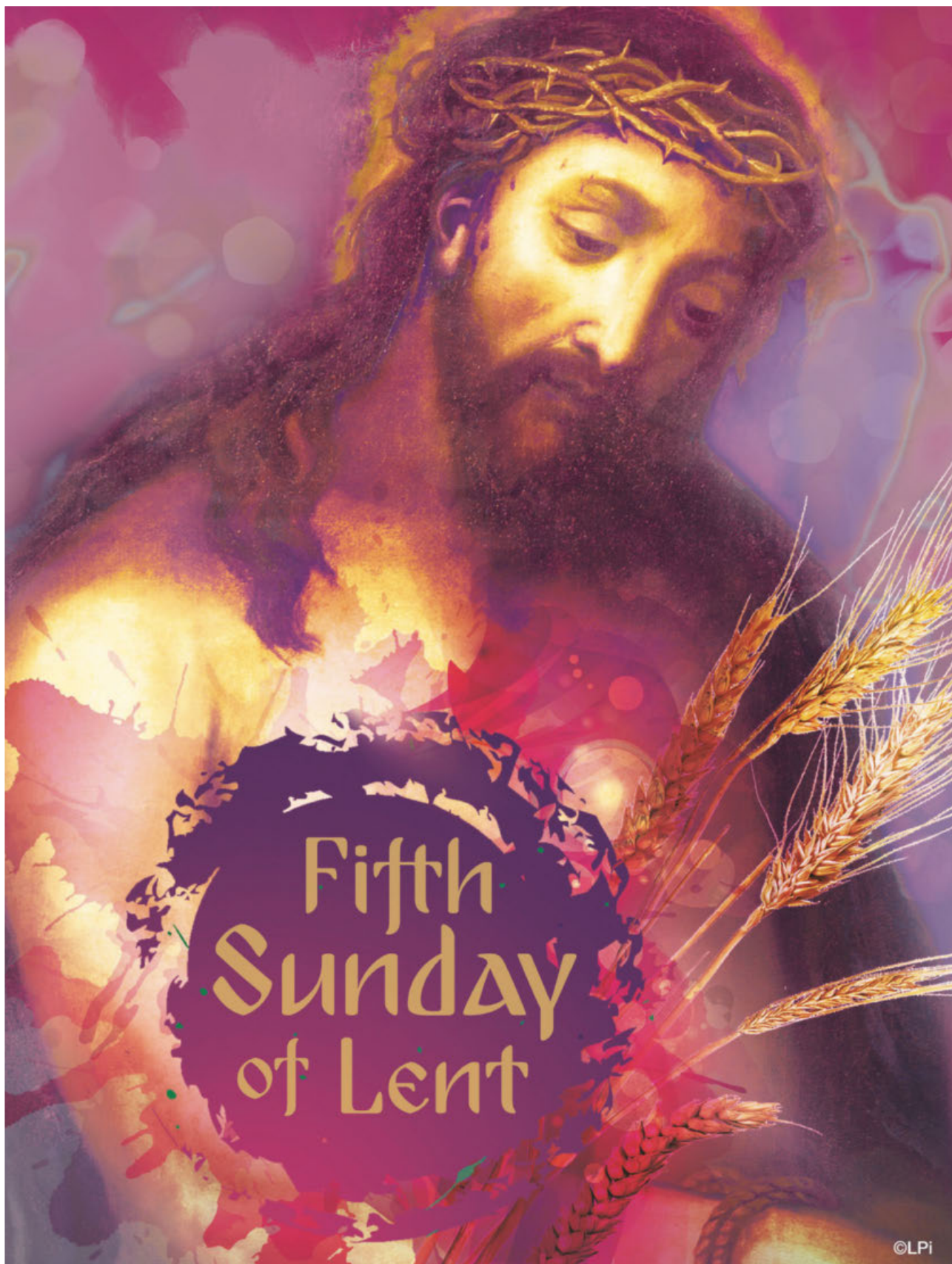

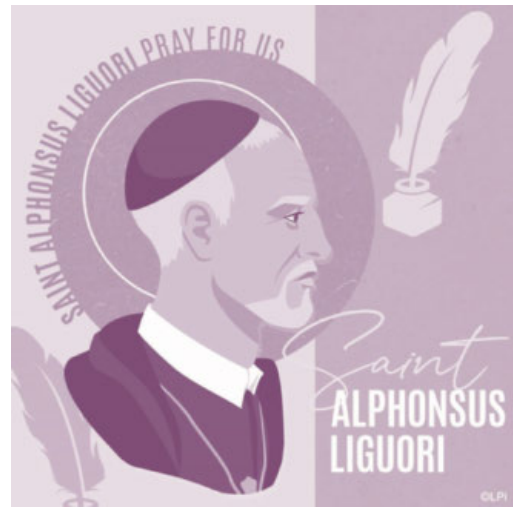

St. Alphonsus Liguori was born in Marianella, near Naples, in Italy. When he was young, he displayed exceptional intelligence and piety, earning a doctorate in civil and canon law by the age of 16. Feeling a calling to dedicate his life to God and the service of others, however, he abandoned his legal career and pursued ordination to the priesthood. He was ordained at the age of 30 in 1726.

Throughout his priestly ministry, Liguori focused on preaching missions and retreats, seeking to renew people's faith and draw them closer to the Eucharist. He frequently preached on the real presence of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament and encouraged frequent reception of Holy Communion as a source of spiritual nourishment and grace.

In 1732, Liguori founded the Redemptorists, a religious congregation dedicated to promoting devotion to the Eucharist and the Blessed Virgin Mary.

St. Alphonsus was canonized as a saint in 1839 and declared a Doctor of the Church in 1871. His spiritual writings, particularly on the Eucharist, continue to inspire and guide the faithful worldwide. As the patron saint of moral theologians, his example reminds believers of the profound love and presence of Christ in the Eucharist and the enduring mercy of God. St. Alphonsus Liguori, pray for us!

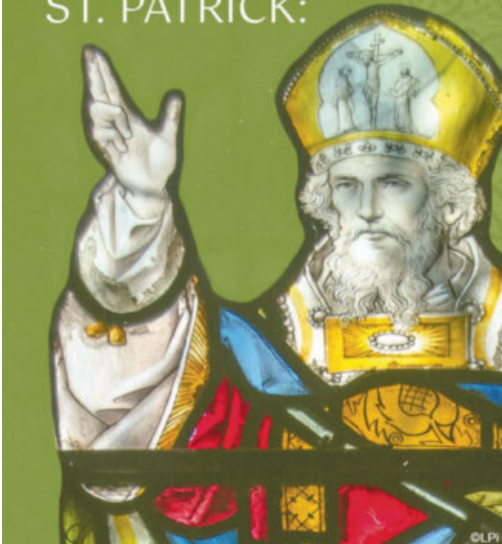
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THREE THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW ABOUT THE **REAL** ST. PATRICK:

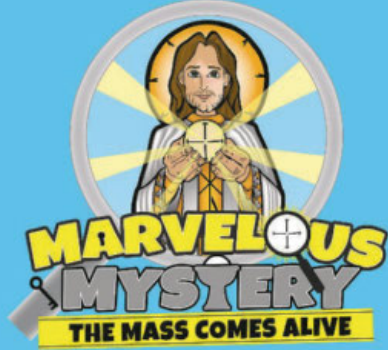

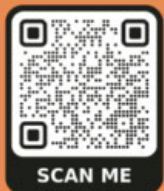

The Answer to the Question

Well-known for his work with The Rescue Project, a Catholic apostolate, Father Riccardo, priest of the Archdiocese of Detroit since 1996, currently serves as the executive director of ACTS XXIX.

Father Riccardo, assisted by Mary Guilfoyle and Albert Faraj, presented "The Answer to the Question" to over 190 diocesan leaders, including Bishop Doherty.

The formation day began with the option of celebrating Mass together at our host location of St. Elizabeth Seton. The morning session dove into the realities in the world and Church. Our world and Church are crying in these ways: Deaths and Despair, Isolation and Decision Fatigue. Suicides among ages 10-14 are the second leading cause of death. The New Great Depression is a Mental Health crisis not an economic one. Father John Riccardo's team asked the question, "How do we get well?"

In the afternoon, the team covered their *Three Essential Principles*:

1. Reacquire a Biblical Worldview.
2. It's not Enough to be on Staff and Restore the Initiative to God.
3. Each of us is called to be a Disciple of Jesus Christ, Whether we are on Staff or not.

The Acts XXIX team introduced two foundational ways for ministry leaders to encounter God. First, through their own healing and then coming together in prayer to discern God's Will for their ministry. They challenged each of us to be convicted with joy and hope that "I am on mission, and through prayer, God continues to guide us in His will and vision." Acts XXIX champions this quote from St. Joan of Arc, "I am not afraid, God is with me. I was born for this," and encourages each of us to embrace this as our calling from God. We were not born in this time by accident, rather, we are here by design and our calling is to share the message of the Gospel with the world.

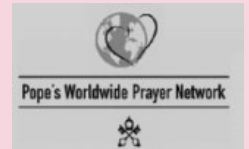
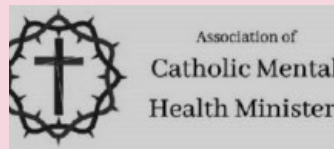

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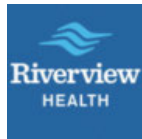
