



Servant of God Darwin Ramos was born into the poorest of families in Pasay City, south of Manila in the Philippines. He lived in the slums of the city where he and his younger sister scavenged trash heaps for things to sell so the family could eat. The first symptoms of Duchenne muscular dystrophy, a genetic disease characterized by the progressive loss of muscle, began to show at age 6.

When he was no longer able to use his legs, he was dropped off at the Libertad station to beg for money.

Members of the ANAK-TnK
Foundation, which works to care for the street children of Manila, convinced Darwin to live at one of their facilities where he would be with other children who also had special needs.

Darwin received the kind of care his condition required, enough food to eat, and education. He was introduced to the Catholic faith and entered a special relationship with Jesus. Never brought low by the disease which attacked him daily, he spoke of his illness as his "mission for Jesus." Darwin was Baptized in 2006 and received his First Communion and Confirmation a year later.

Servant of God Darwin Ramos died at the age of 17 in 2012. He was declared a Servant of God in 2018, and the diocese of Cubao (Philippines) opened the cause of canonization in 2019.

WHAT'S YOUR HEARTH CAKE?

"Get up and eat or the journey will be too much for you." I've been to a lot of meetings in my years of work in the Church, and you can take my word for it: the ones with snacks just seem to go better.

I don't know what it is exactly. Maybe it's just that people are in a more agreeable mood if you show up with donuts. Or maybe it's about the very real sense of



community and camaraderie that is created at a table where people are engaging in that most human of tasks — eating — beside one another. I think a big part of it comes down to the simple fact that we're all just nicer people when we're fed.

This rings true spiritually, too. We simply must remain fed if we, in turn, are to feed others. Think of a time when you have neglected your relationship with God — when you haven't fed yourself with whatever it is that you need to remain committed to the journey of a Christian life. Is it Mass attendance? Is it prayer or Scripture reading? Is it time with your small group or conversation with a trusted friend who knows your soul? What sustains your ability to be a good disciple, a good steward? What inspires you to give more freely, to love more abundantly?

Focus on Hospitality in the Pastorate

 A focus on personal invitation has helped to grow ministries throughout the parish.

 Holy Spirit Parish engaged with Entertaining Angels and has seen growth in the number of parishioners serving as greeters in the parish.

The culture of the parish is drawing people – they like being here, have a sense of welcomeness and community, included right away – if they don't know someone, they introduce themselves, welcome them in – particularly those who come by themselves.

 They have a strong Sacramental focus on those things that will get them to Heaven – along with being personal and engaging. Pickleball Builds Community at Holy Spirit

 After putting in pickleball courts in at the parish, the ministry has grown quickly. They now have groups playing six days a week.

· This year at the parish picnic they had

a tournament with new partners and new opponents every game – a great way for friendships to grow.

 The teams have even begun to participate in a local trivia night.

Summer Field Study with St. John Vianney Youth

 A new youth ministry trip last summer was led by Megan and Fr. Cole Daily.

 The focus was on encountering God through Beauty (hiking, Red Rocks visit), encountering God through Vocations (visited some religious communities), and encountering Christ through the Poor (Missionaries of Charity, Christ in the City).

• The fruit from this trip is showing up this year because youth aren't just showing up for YM meetings, but they want to be here and they're interacting within the parish. It has also created a trip that is seen as a rite of passage that younger children want to go in the future.


