

1850-1917

St. Frances Xavier Cabrini was born in Sant'Angelo Lodigiano, Italy, and dreamed of being a missionary. After being educated by the Daughters of the Sacred Heart, she was denied entry to the order due to poor health. She became a teacher and administrator at an orphanage run by the Sisters of Providence, where she made her vows and took the name Xavier in honor of St. Francis Xavier in 1877.

When the orphanage closed in 1880, St. Frances Xavier Cabrini founded the Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. In 1887, she sought permission from Pope Leo XIII to go to China, but he directed her to the U.S. instead. In 1889, she and six sisters arrived in New York to serve Italian immigrants. Despite facing anti-Italian and anti-immigrant sentiment, even within the Church, she stayed and provided education and healthcare to the Italian Catholic community.

St. Frances Xavier Cabrini served Italian immigrants across the U.S., becoming a citizen in 1909. She later expanded her work to Central and South America and Europe, founding hospitals, orphanages, and 67 schools. Known for her deep spirituality, she often entered a trancelike state during the Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament.

St. Frances Xavier Cabrini died at her Columbus Hospital in Chicago and was canonized in 1946 by Pope Pius XII, becoming the first U.S. citizen to be canonized. She is the Universal Patron of Immigrants.





Is the Catholic Mass the Same Worldwide?

Yes and no. The essential structure of the Roman Rite Mass is consistent globally, following the Roman Missal. However, local customs, such as liturgical colors, regional saints' feasts, or processions, can vary. Even in the U.S., for example, the Solemnity of the Ascension is celebrated on different days depending on the diocese. These variations, while preserving the core of the rite, reflect the cultural richness envisioned by the Second Vatican Council.

How can a priest counsel married couples if he's never been married?

A counselor's effectiveness isn't solely based on personal experience. For example, we don't expect an oncologist to have had cancer to treat it. Priests, through their training, experience, and exposure to various relationships, are well-equipped to counsel couples. They help couples explore relationship dynamics and, with the support of married couples and trained counselors, most parishes provide excellent marriage preparation.


Everyday Stewardship- An Increase in Love

I am a mom of ten. My oldest son is a priest. I should have it all together, right? Not even close. I have struggled for most of my life comparing my flaws to the perfection of other women. These women had matching shoes and purses while I felt excited just to find my shoes. Other women were immaculately dressed while I couldn't seem to leave the house without toddler boogers or baby spit up on my shoulder. I once spent an entire day thinking I was looking pretty good, to only later realize my pants were covered in Nutella. I literally looked like I was covered in poop. Poop, snot, and baby vomit seemed to be my identifying characteristics. The evil one told me I needed to work harder to be like these other women. They are perfect and glamorous, and I need to become them. But the harder I worked the more exhausted, lonely, and sadder I became. I allowed the evil one to steal my peace and joy because I listened to him telling me to despise my design.

"Consider the wildflowers, how they grow: they neither toil nor spin; but I tell you, not even Solomon in all his glory clothed himself like one of these." Luke 12:27I

I was praying with this scripture verse and the word that stood out to me was wildflowers. Why? What would God want to tell me about wildflowers. He must know that I love roses. I love their perfection, their beauty, and even how the thorns surrounding them seem to heighten their glamour. Roses are my thing. If I was a flower, I would want to be a rose. I kept praying with this verse and I had this mental image of this garden in the middle of a field. This garden was filled with beautiful flowers of every kind mixed with weeds. It was stunning and a little messy and it was exactly how God desired it. He formed each one and He loved each one. Then God showed me this wild droopy purple flower within that garden, and I knew that was me. I was not meant to be a rose. I was meant to be a beautiful wildflower. His design of me was perfect . . . perfectly messy.

God created each of us unique and beautiful. Kingdom Builders is an apostolate that was born out of the desire for all women to know their beauty, worth, and authority as a beloved daughter of the King. That knowledge only comes from a deep encounter with Jesus Christ.

Kingdom Builders raises up seven women in a Catholic Parish to host a monthly Eucharistic event. At this event (called a Gathering), we begin with a Teaching that incorporates the Sunday Scriptures. It includes laughter, learning, and real-life application for any woman's life. We conclude with Eucharistic Adoration laced with silence and music. 


